- Syrup


### **Breakfast will be served from 9:00 AM-10:30 AM**

The 2019 Lutheran Community Services fundraiser and luncheon was held on Sunday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> at the STAR Center in Tacoma. Those attending from Bethany Lutheran Church included Kathy Mettler, Louise Harris, Susan Fordice, and Kirk and Nancy Woodward. Lutheran Community Services provides help in many forms: Behavioral Health; Family and Community; Refugee and Immigration; Child Welfare; Aging and Independent Living; and Crime Victim services. This year's theme was Real People, Real Solutions. The programs highlighted included Circles of Hope and Santa for Seniors. Two Lutheran churches partnered to help a family of four who fled the terrors in Venezuela. Volunteers helped them transition to a new country and welcomed them into the community. The family attended the luncheon and personally thanked all for helping them and making them feel welcome. The Senior for Santa program started out by seeing a need for a couple seniors at Christmas time, providing gifts. This successful program now serves more than 1000 each Christmas.
