# NOTICE OF CLUB T SHIRT CHANGE

At the September 7th Turners Club Board meeting, it was decided that the club would end the annual practice of supplying a new Tee shirt to every regular member as part of the annual membership. The cost of the shirts has risen over the years and there is no longer a \$10 Tee shirt to be had despite the discount rates we have received for many years from Leadmasters company. Shirts go higher than \$16 each sometimes. If you remember, we stopped providing shirts to our honorary members a few years back with the option of allowing them to purchase the shirts at a discounted rate. The Board did not want to raise the dues this year to cover the cost of the shirts. Many members have expressed that they have plenty of tee shirts as well. The plan is to have a Club tee shirt available for purchase by the members. Once we have our own design, we may be able to expand it to other types of shirts and clothing items. I know some have been asking for a jacket also. By using a digital printing process, the design can be kept on file for many years without the need for "making new screens" and without the additional cost of new screens every year. Also this allows a faster turnaround time as digitalized companies have only a 10 day turnaround time on orders.

# Friend of Rollo Trip By Don Udlock

On Sept 22 several members of our fishing club accompanied 30 sixth grade students from Rockdale elementary school on a Friends of Rollo fishing trip out of 22 St landing. We met at about 7:00 AM on the Monte Carlo for a day of helping kids go fishing. We assembled 35 rods with a dropper loop and waited for the kids. The bus arrived at 9:30 (late as usual) so we went bottom fishing instead of looking for yellowtail. It was a perfect day, flat ocean, very little breeze or current and blue skies. After some instructions from the crew they were ready to go. It didn't take the kids very long to get used to the boat, as usual they headed to the bait tank, and one boy found a small dead anchovy and offered it to one of the girls. She wanted nothing to do with it, told him to get away with that thing (more about her later). The kids caught on very quickly, put on an anchovy or a piece of cut squid and send it to the bottom Very soon rockfish started coming up, the volunteer would unhook it and the kid would put it into the ice chest We were in about 300 feet of water and a couple kids said their arms were getting tired, but none of them slowed down. Back to the girl that would not touch the anchovy, Later I watched her go to the bait tank, get an anchovy, put it on the hook and send it to the bottom. In a short while she reeled up a fish, had it taken off the hook, and put it into the ice chest. Then she did it all over again. She told me what a wonderful day she was having. Some of the kids will surely be fishers, one said he'd caught 21, another 17 and so on .Well, it wasn't quite that way The deckhand filleted fish till we arrived back at the dock. I put 10 to 12 fillets into 35 bags. In total they caught about 250 fish, about 8 around. The price of the trip for each kid was to write a one page story about their day, I was able to read all of them before I mailed them to F.O.R. One thing common to all of them was thank you to Friends of Rollo, the crew, the cook (hot dogs) and the volunteers. Most said it was their first time on a boat or catching a fish. All of them said it was the best field trip ever.

All of us had a great time with the kids. As usual they all got along well with each other did as they were supposed to and had a day to remember for a long time. Thank you to all of the volunteers that came along. Back at the school I spoke with the principal about next fall, she is all for another trip. If you think you might like to come along, now is the time to begin thinking about it. Don
