

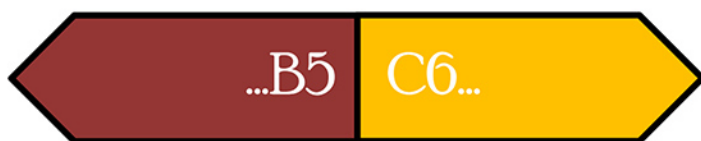
Color-Coded Arrows from Fretboard Toolbox

I have no formal musical training, so when I started to play around with reading piano music, I created these arrows to cut out and tape to my piano so I could see where the different octaves are found. The green C4 is “Middle C” on the piano, so you would tape the blue B3 & green C4 right between the B and Middle C keys on the piano. The black line dividing the letters (in the middle of the arrows) should go right in between the B and C notes in each of the octaves that your keyboard has. These colors of each octave match the colors of my “Standard Notation Jigs”, located at:
