Re: **Rome City Town Wide Clean up – Saturday, August 19, 2023**

Noble County Disposal, Inc. will provide trucks needed for the collection of Spring Clean Up items.

Appliances without Freon: washers, dryers, dishwashers, microwave ovens, and hot water heaters. These items will carry no extra charge. Refrigerators and freezers will be billed at \$70.00 each—these are to be paid for at the town hall and tagged prior to pick up. Non-tagged Freon items will be left behind. Tires are \$10.00 each for 16" or smaller without rims and \$15.00 each with rims. Tires 17" or larger are \$15.00 without rims, \$20.00 each with rims and tractor tires are \$20.00. These also need to be paid for at the town hall and tagged prior to pick up. **We will not haul any electronics of any kind.** Any electronics out to curb will be left behind. You can let the residents know they can be recycled at our office on Highway 6 during normal business hours.

Wood needs to be in 4ft pieces or less and bundled so it can be handled easily. Carpet needs to be in 4ft rolls or less and bundled or tied. Roofing material will be taken in small manageable amounts. Any huge piles of roofing material will be left behind.

Items that will not be taken: Hazardous materials (oil, wet paint, household chemicals), yard waste, concrete, brick, ashes or normal household trash.

All items are to be picked up at the curb—**no alley pick up**. All items need to be at the curb by 6:00am the morning of the clean up. We will go down each street one time. There will be no back tracking for anyone not putting out on time or coming back later in the week. **Any questionable piles will be left behind.**

The Clean Up will begin at **6:00am** on the day scheduled and will continue until all items are hauled.

Scavenging of piles has always been a problem and makes our job harder than it should be. Any piles that have been scavenged through and made a real mess will be left behind. It is not our responsibility to clean up home owner's yards. **We will not come in later in the week to pick up this material.** Any solution to this problem would be greatly appreciated.
