Level	Description
New	Student has had pony rides or take a few lessons before, but still requires assistance.
Beginner	Student has taken lessons before, is comfortable riding independently at the walk, requires some assistance at the trot
Novice	Student is comfortable walking and trotting independently and has lessoned regularly. Student is ready to canter (or is learning to canter currently in classes) Student can groom and tack independently
Intermediate	Student is comfortable at the walk, trot and canter and is ready to learn jumping. Student is confident and able to groom and tack independently
Advanced	Student is learning jumping and has completed small courses of cross rails or low verticals. Student can groom, tack, and mount independently.

\*Costs: \$450.00 per week – \$100.00 non-refundable deposit for each week due with application. \$350.00 non- refundable balance for each week is due first day of each week of camp. Sign up for three or more weeks and receive a discount of \$25.00 per week. Please make all checks or money orders payable to Hasty Acres. (Sorry no credit cards accepted).

\*Each student must have a pair of low boots or laced shoe with a hard, smooth sole and a small heel. Long pants for riding are required (Children are allowed to wear shorts when not riding).

Riding helmets are required as well but may be borrowed from us. Please send lunch, several water bottles, and a snack with your child. (Refrigerator is available for items which need to be kept cold, please make sure the owner's name is clearly visible on the outside). We also recommend children bring hand sanitizer, sun block, insect repellent, which they can easily apply themselves.

Our basic riding program runs in weekly sessions. Each student has instruction each day, with the remainder of the day spent in educational sessions on varying aspects of caring for the horse. Topics include such basics as saddling and bridling, different riding disciplines, parts of the horse, basic first aid, as well as more advanced topics of conformation, judging, and lameness in horses.

The program during weeks of operation runs Monday–Friday from 9:00 am till 3:00pm. We ask that everyone arrive and leave on time. Children should be dropped off and picked up in front of the main barn. After camp care available, please call ahead to arrange.
