Job Description: The Senior IA Security Specialist, (IAVM/ISSM) will disseminate, collect, and

report on DOD IAVM patching via the Vulnerability Remediation Asset Manager (VRAM), or other Navy approved method. He or she will insure the patch or update has been approved by a Government configuration management board before implementation. The IAVM is responsible for preventing and investigating unauthorized intrusion attempts into Government systems/devices.

Responsibilities:

 Review a Continuous Monitoring site to ensure systems/devices are not compromised.

- Review the current Information Assurance Vulnerability Alert (IAVA) compliance, STIG, and Microsoft update releases to identify changes including patches or service pack updates needed.
- Ensure technical security safeguards are maintained to provide controlled user access, integrity of electronic mail, applications, and end-user data.
- In accordance with DoD guidance, ensure systems are properly configured to provide the latest cyber security protection.
- Provide support in the administration and/or execution of new tasking defined in CTO guidance.
- If not able to achieve 100% IAVM compliance through permanent fix actions, issue Plan of Action and Milestones (POA&M)
- Meet the timelines directed by the IAVM process.

- B.S. in a Computer Information Systems or related field
