



ANNUAL CLUB ELECTIONS

Each year, at the October General Membership Meeting, members are encouraged to nominate themselves, or someone else, to one of the five (5) positions that comprise the Club's Board of Directors.

The five Board seats consist of President, Vice President, Membership Coordinator, Treasurer, and Secretary. Each of these positions are expected to serve not less than one year, and not more than two years.

The positions of Webmaster, Sunshine Coordinator, and Newsletter Editor are not board positions, but are important club positions to which the Board asks club members to fill as needed.

You may nominate yourself, or someone else, for more than one of the five Board positions. In the unlikely event that the nominee is not elected to their preferred position, they could, however, be elected to the alternate position(s) for which they were nominated.

Nominations can be sent via email to the Club Secretary, Paul Styka at p.styka@sbcglobal.net. The nomination period ends on October 31, 2021.

At the General Membership Meeting, scheduled for Tuesday, November 9, 2021, with a quorum of not less than 20% of the membership present, all names nominated will be announced and voted upon by a raise of hands. The nominee with the most votes received for each position, is elected. Terms of service will commence on January 1, 2022.

If you want your vote to count, you must be present at the November General Membership Meeting.
