• Please remember that our teachers cannot supervise children outside of class time. Why not find a "buddy" parent in your child's class to look after your child in the event you are delayed at pick-up time?

## **Our Teacher and Aides**

We are pleased to welcome back our wonderful teacher, Mrs. Miller. This will be Mrs. Miller's 14<sup>th</sup> year with the school. She is a certified Early Childhood Educator, trained to encourage creativity, discovery, and thinking amongst the students. We are also welcoming back our fantastic Teacher's Aides, Mrs. McConnell and

Mrs. Fozzard. Mrs. Fozzard has been with the preschool for over 30 years, serving as both a teacher and as an aide. Mrs. McConnell has been with the school for more than 8 years. All staff members are devoted professionals who love children and are dedicated to each student's development. They are very excited to be working together to provide a stimulating and positive experience for all of our children.



#### Fundraising

Did you know that Glenbrook Community Preschool is not part of the Calgary Board of Education? As an independent, non-profit organization, we pay rent for our preschool classrooms, purchase our own supplies, and pay for caretaking services. Our program has low student:teacher ratios and no mandatory classroom volunteer commitments! We try to keep our tuition fees low and accessible to all families, so each year we typically run 2 fundraisers, one prior to Christmas, and a second in the spring. **All of our fundraising drives are voluntary.** We are still looking for a volunteer to run the fundraisers for this school year. Please let the preschool know if you are interested in this or other volunteer opportunities!

# Parking

Glenbrook Elementary School has been very welcoming of our preschool. You can help ensure we maintain this positive relationship by respecting the school's rules regarding parking and child drop off and pick up, as outlined in the Parent Handbook. Please remember – enter only through the south side entrance, and do not park in the staff parking lot. Parking is available on the street at the back of the school and in the alley, noting the no parking signage and being careful not to block neighbourhood garages. Thank you for your cooperation.

# **Provincial Child Care Subsidy**

Did you know that the provincial government subsidizes preschool fees for some families? There is a maximum household income, which varies according to family size, but it is more generous than many people realize!
