

Tournament Format Explanations

JOAD Indoor (AZ State JOAD Indoor, JOAD Indoor Nats)

- Recurve, Compound, Barebow
- Bowmen, Cub, Cadet, Junior
- 18 Meters
- 60 Arrows (1 shooting time) (20 ends of 3 arrows)
- Recurve Cadet, Recurve Junior, Barebow Cadet, Barebow Junior, All Compound are on 40cm Target Face (single spot, vertical or triangle. However, some venues may omit any target face)
- Recurve Bowmen, Barebow Bowmen, Recurve Cub, Barebow Cub are on 60cm Target Face Single Spot (possible to have up to 4 archers on a target face)
- Compound Inner 10 Scoring, Recurve and Barebow Outer 10 Scoring

Indoor Championships (AZ State Indoor, Indoor Nats)

- Recurve, Compound, Barebow
- All Age Divisions
- 18 Meters
- 120 Arrows (2 shooting times over 2 days)(40 ends of 3 arrows)
- All divisions are on 40cm target face (ss, v, t. However, some venues may omit any target face)
- Compound Inner 10 Scoring, Recurve and Barebow Outer 10 Scoring

ABFAA SW Sectional

- Recurve, Compound, Barebow
- NFAA Rules (different than what we do)
- NFAA Age Divisions
- 20 Yards
- 60 Arrows (1 shooting time) (20 ends of 3 arrows)
- All divisions are on a 40cm target face. Single Spot and Triangle only
- All Outer 10 (not eligible for JOAD Pins)

The Vegas Shoot

- NFAA Rules
- Recurve, Compound, Barebow
- 20 Yards
- Not every bow type has every age group
- All Compound shoot 40cm target face (single spot or triangle)
- Recurve Cub and Youth shoot 60cm target face
- All other Recurve shoot 40cm target face
- Barebow shoot 40cm target face
- Cub and Youth shoot 2 rounds of 30 arrows over two days, 3 arrow ends
- All other divisions shoot 3 rounds of 30 arrows over three days, 3 arrow ends
- Outer 10 scoring all divisions

NFAA Championship (ABFAA State and NFAA Indoor National)

- NFAA 5 spot rules
- Recurve, Compound, maybe Barebow
- NFAA age groups
- All divisions shoot NFAA 5 spot (or their blue single spot)
- 20 Yards
- 4 ends of 5 arrows

USAT Series (Arizona Cup, SoCal Showdown, Buckeye Classic/Texas Showdown, Gator Cup)

- Compound and Recurve (no Barebow)
- Cadet, Junior, Senior, Masters
- All Compound Shoot 50 Meters on 80cm 6 ring
- Cadet and Master Recurve Shoot 60 Meters on 122cm
- Junior and Senior Recurve Shoot 70 Meters on 122cm
- Qualifying 72 arrows (12 ends of 6 arrows) Day 1
- All Divisions cut to the top 64 archers
- Elimination Rounds Compound cumulative scoring 5 ends 3 arrows
- Elimination Rounds Recurve set scoring 3 arrow ends

Arizona JOAD Outdoor

- Compound, Recurve and Barebow
- Bowman, Cub, Cadet, Junior Only
- Barebow Bowman, Barebow Cub, Recurve Bowman 30m on 122cm target face
- Compound Bowman, Compound Cub 30m on 80cm 6 Ring
- Recurve Cub, Barebow Cadet, Barebow Junior 50m on 122cm target face

- Compound Cadet, Compound Junior 50m on 80cm 6 Ring
- Recurve Cadet 60m on 122cm target face
- Recurve Junior 70m on 122cm target face
- Saturday Qualification Round 72 Arrow (12 ends of 6 arrows)
- Sunday Elimination Round Recurve Set Points, Compound Cumulative Points

900 Round (Papago 900, Halloween Shoot, Masters Outdoor State Championships)

- Compound, Recurve and Barebow
- All ages
- Distances based on age and bow discipline
- 5 end of 6 arrows per distance
- 3 distances
- All Archers shoot on 122cm target face

Collegiate Outdoor Championship

- USAT Rules
- Must belong to a Collegiate Archery Team
- If College does not have a team, can shoot as an independent

July Juggernaut

- Compound, Recurve, Barebow
- All Ages, Bow Types and Genders Combined
- 60 Arrows at 25 meters Qualifying Round on Day 1
- Round Robin for Top 36 Compound Archers and Top 12 Rec/Bar (combined) on Day 2
- Shot on NFAA 5 Ring/Single Spot
- Round Robins use special set scoring

JOAD Outdoor Target Nationals

- Compound, Recurve and Barebow
- Bowman, Cub, Cadet, Junior Only
- Barebow Bowman, Barebow Cub, Recurve Bowman 30m on 122cm target face
- Compound Bowman, Compound Cub 30m on 80cm 6 Ring
- Recurve Cub, Barebow Cadet, Barebow Junior 50m on 122cm target face
- Compound Cadet, Compound Junior 50m on 80cm 6 Ring
- Recurve Cadet 60m on 122cm target face
- Recurve Junior 70m on 122cm target face

- Day 1 Qualification Round 1st 72 Arrows (12 ends of 6 arrows)
- Day 2 Qualification Round 2nd 72 Arrows (12 ends of 6 arrows)
- Day 3 Elimination Round Recurve Set Points, Compound Cumulative Points
- Day 4 Optional Team Rounds

Summer Sizzle

- Compound, Recurve, Barebow
- 1 Day tournament
- 60 Arrows at 25m on 60cm Vertical or Single Spot (archers share target face)
- 20 ends of 3 arrows

National Target Championships

- Compound, Recurve and Barebow
- Senior and Master Only
- Barebow 50m on 122cm target face
- Compound 50m on 80cm 6 Ring
- Recurve Master 60m on 122cm target face
- Recurve Senior 70m on 122cm target face
- Day 1 Qualification Round 1st 72 Arrows (12 ends of 6 arrows)
- Day 2 Qualification Round 2nd 72 Arrows (12 ends of 6 arrows)
- Day 3 Elimination Round Recurve Set Points, Compound Cumulative Points

ABFAA International Round

- NFAA Rules
- Compound, Recurve and Barebow
- Cub and Youth shoot 20 to 50 yards in 5 yard increments
- All other age groups shoot 20 to 65 yards in 5 yard increments
- 3 Arrow ends
- 92cm target face

Arizona State Outdoor

- Compound, Recurve and Barebow
- Bowman, Cub, Cadet, Junior, Senior and Master
- Barebow Bowman, Barebow Cub, Recurve Bowman 30m on 122cm target face
- Compound Bowman, Compound Cub 30m on 80cm 6 Ring
- Recurve Cub, Barebow Cadet, Barebow Junior, Barebow Senior, Barebow Master 50m on 122cm target face
- Compound Cadet, Compound Junior, Compound Senior, Compound Master 50m on 80cm 6 Ring
- Recurve Cadet, Recurve Master 60m on 122cm target face

- Recurve Junior, Recurve Senior 70m on 122cm target face
- Saturday Qualification Round 72 Arrow (12 ends of 6 arrows)
- Sunday Elimination Round Recurve Set Points, Compound Cumulative Points

ABFAA Classic 600

- NFAA Rules
- Young Adult and older 40/50/60 yards
- Youth 30/40/50 yards
- Cub 10/20/30 yards
- 4 ends of 5 arrows per distance
- 92cm target face

Copper Classic

- All archers compete head to head regardless of age, bow type or gender
- Saturday is 60 Arrow qualifying round
- Cut to top 48 total regardless of bow type
- Top 48 are flighted and shoot round robins
- Hybrid rules, read registration

Candy Cane Crunch

- Compound, Recurve, Barebow
- 1 Day tournament
- 60 Arrows at 25m on 60cm Vertical or Single Spot
- X is an 11
- Each day is 20 ends of 3 arrows

Vegas Vengeance

- Compound, Recurve, Barebow
- 1 Day tournament
- 60 Arrows at 25m on 40cm Triangle or Single Spot
- 20 ends of 3 arrows

DSA Iron Archer

- Compound, Recurve, Barebow
- All Ages, Bow Types and Genders Combined
- 60 Arrows at 18 meters Qualifying Round on Day 1
- Round Robin for Top 48 Archers Combined
- Shot on 40cm Single or Triangle
- Round Robins use World Archery set scoring
