

What is Commitment?


- Commitment is being dedicated to a cause.

At Public Places:-

- By attending the events hosted by our ulemas knowing that you have to support the right social causes.
- By feeling that every muslim is an ambassador of his or her faith and behave appropriately.

predicament was commitment. So I put my focus on that.


