Together they built a wonderful home and family and celebrated 61, almost 62, years together. Ron was a dedicated dairy farmer and crop farmer. In 1958 Ron won the Outstanding State Farmer Gold Award. Ron was very involved in his church and Lutheran school. He was a Trustee and on the Finance Committee at St. John Lutheran Church. Ron also held a position on the school board at St. John Lutheran School. Ron was a life-long dairy farmer and loved working with his children milking cows. Ron held a position at the Sebewaing Local MMPA, a 35 year member of the Michigan Milk Producers Association, won an award in 1989 for Outstanding Cooperator in the conservation of soil, water and related resources. One of many joys in life for Ron was being involved in the Two-Cylinder Club and volunteering at the Octagon Barn driving people around on his tractor. Ron also loved farming with his two sons, Todd and Darrin.
