1917 - 1997

Felix F. Skonieczny, Sr., age 79 of Pigeon (formerly of Roseville), passed away Thursday, October 2 at Tendercare in Cass City.

He was born in Detroit on December 24, 1917, the son of the late Felix and Marianne Skonieczny. On December 26, 1942 he was united in marriage to Lillian Szostek in Detroit. She preceded him in death on July 5, 1993.
