Trojans defeated in bid for second straight state title by Union 27-17! Win streak ends at 22!

In a hard fought contest Friday night at Skelly Stadium, Jenks' bid for a second straight 6A state title came up short when they were defeated by Union 27-17.

The Trojans came into the game ranked #1 in the state and #6 nationally with a 22 game winning streak on the line. Union came into the game ranked #2 in the state and #25 nationally and were looking for revenge from their loss to the Trojans earlier in the season in the first annual "Backyard Bowl".

The Trojans were frustrated on the ground as Union held QB Andrew Brewer and RB Freddie Carolina back from their typical game yardage. Brewer was also disappointed in the air throwing 4 interceptions and completing less than 40% of his passes.

On defense, the Trojans could not stop the powerful Redskins on the ground after the first quarter and they drove relentlessly against the Trojans. When Union went to the air, they hit Jenks in their weakest area scoring three touchdowns.
