

Desert Storm 2018 Shootout Operations

REQUIRED ITEMS:

Be sure to have proper **required** safety equipment:

- Helmets
- VHF Radio
- Kill switch and Lanyard
- Life Jackets for each person on board
- Current Boat Registration or Coast Guard Documentation
- Boat Insurance
- Intact and safe rigging/ drives and steering
- Must be able to pass a breathalyzer at the drivers meeting (April 21,2018 @ 08:00)
- Maximum of 2 people on board
- All person(s) are limited to 18 years of age and older

****EARLY REGISTRATION OPEN UNTIL APRIL 6, 2018****

- If participating in the DS Poker Run, Shootout is an additional \$100.00.
- If not participating in the DS Poker Run, Shootout is \$400.00.

****AT THE EVENT REGISTRATION APRIL 19, 2018 – April 21, 2018****

- At the Event SO Registration if participating in the DS Poker Run, is \$200.00.
- At the Event SO Registration if not participating in the DS Poker Run, is \$500.00.

TECH INSPECTION:

COMPLETE and PASS tech inspection on one of the following:

EMAIL Christina@StormPokerRuns.com with your choice for TECH INSPECTION.

- DRY TECH:** Desert Storm Street Party Participants can get dry tech done, while on display.
THURSDAY, April 19, 2018 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM ****PLEASE MAKE NOTE if you choose DRY TECH you will STILL have to PASS kill switch efficiency at one of the water techs. ****
- WATER TECH:** On your assigned slip at LBR. FRIDAY, APRIL 20, 2018 between 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
- WATER TECH:** OR the courtesy dock at LBR. FRIDAY APRIL 20, 2018 between 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.

DAY of the SHOOTOUT:

- Attend the mandatory driver's meeting on April 21, 2018 @ 08:00 King Arthur Room at LBR.
- Pass a breathalyzer at the drivers meeting
- Turn in your RED TAG TECH PASS (given upon completion of tech inspection)
- Get a BOAT DECAL
- Head to the staging area
- Once in staging call Course Control to get in QUE
- Once advised from Course Control "NEXT UP" get gear ready (lanyard, helmet, life jacket) and idle towards the start tetrahedrons.
- You will then be notified course clear, and you will see a GREEN FLAG atop the START HOUSEBOAT, you can begin your run.
 - Get on plane heading towards the radar / trap boat remain at 40 MPH or less. Every MPH over 40, your end speed will be deducted 1 MPH (PENALTY).
 - If you have a GREEN FLAG your 40 MPH or less / YELLOW FLAG your over 40 MPH / RED FLAG ABORT RUN IMMEDIATELY
 - If green or yellow flag keep on course towards the finish boat, your final MPH will be clocked at the finish tetrahedrons just **before the FINISH BOAT** not as you PASS THE FINISH BOAT. If at any point you see a RED FLASHING LIGHT from the finish boat ABORT RUN IMMEDIATELY.
- Once you complete your pass if you would like to make another pass idle through the spectator area back to the staging area.
- Repeat the process as many times as daylight will allow.
