Bowler must have been registered in a BCAO Grand Prix Program for 2016-17 season.

Advance registration required. Entries closed 3 days prior to each event. No confirmations will be mailed. Unless you hear from us you should arrive to bowl one half hour prior to your requested time slot(s). See reverse for complete tournament rules.

Rules

- 1. All entrants must be a registered Grand Prix Scholarship participant <u>in good standing from the 2016-17</u> <u>season</u> at a BCAO Grand Prix Center. In other words, bowlers must be vested in Grand Prix by bowling and participating in the Grand Prix program for at least one year.
- 2. This is **NOT** a USBC certified tournament.
- 3. This is a singles event. Bowlers will be divided into four divisions based on their entering average. Divisions will be determined after the entry close date.
- 4. Bowlers may enter all squads at each house, and are eligible for more than one scholarship prize. Both locations are open to eligible Grand Prix bowlers in the state.
- 5. Averages used will be the highest verifiable final average of 21 games or more listed on bowl.com from the 2016-2017 season. If a bowler's 2016-2017 average is not listed on bowl.com, a final 2016-17 standing sheet must be included with the entry. If the bowler's 2016-2017 average is from a league that is a sport league, the bowler will be re-rated based on USBC rule #202. Handicap will be 100% of 220. We reserve the right to re-rate any bowler.
- 6. The calculation of awards will take place within 30 days after the completion of both events and is the sole responsibility of the tournament Director (or the Grand Prix Tournament Committee.) Scholarship money will be added to the bowler's accrued Grand Prix fund and will be subject to all the conditions governing those. (Money is sent directly to the college as explained in the Grand Prix program manual. If the bowler does not remain in the sport, tournament winnings and all other earnings will be redistributed to the bowler's home center.)
- 7. Late bowlers must begin the event in the frame bowled at the time of their arrival. No pins for frames missed.
- 8. USBC Youth rules govern all bowlers. Only tournament officials, lane monitors, and bowlers are permitted in the bowler's area.
- 9. Twelve (\$12.00) dollars must be submitted for each squad entered. Entries closed three days prior to the first shift of each event. **NO EXTENSIONS, NO EXCEPTIONS.**
