Luck of the Draw

- *Teams are determined by those shooting Sunday's 16-yard event. All shooters' names, regardless of class, will be drawn.
- *Teams are drawn at random Saturday evening.
- *Entries for blankets'/buckles' teams will be closed at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday.
- *If attending only on Sunday and you wish to be eligible for the team draw, you must use the pre-squad form or register before 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. (No phone calls accepted)
- *Because a full five-man team is required, it is regretful that late entries that make up a short squad will not be eligible for the team drawing. (In the past club members have worked to make sure no one is left out because of a short squad.)
- *Teams will be posted at the scoreboard after the 16-yard event begins on Sunday.
- *Teams tied for either the blankets or buckles will shoot off.

GENERAL INFORMATION


Eye and Ear protection is mandatory while shooting. All Orange White Flyers targets will be thrown.

- Handicap yardage will be determined by ATA & PITA cards.
- If ties for cash prizes occur, money will be divided, "high" gun system.
- No withdrawal of option money after an event begins.
- Errors in score must be corrected before moving to the next post.
- Squads will not be called. Please watch the on-deck board for your squad. Quick turn around from 16 to handicap.
- Practice trap will be available Saturday and Sunday all day.
- All pay-offs will be made by mail.
- Only Club Management will change traps.
- 100-Straight pins are available see person at the scoreboard.
- RV hook-ups: Call Paul Klingele at 509-945-0604
- \$20.00 night. Free dry camping.
- Kitchen will be open both days for breakfast & lunch.
- Potluck after Shoot is done on Saturday (6:00pm).
- Special event auction will be held Sunday morning. Proceeds go towards YVSA facility improvements.
- Office will be open for handicapping & squadding Friday evening depending on the time the cashier arrives.

2025 WSPITA Doubles League

WSPITA Doubles League update:

This year, there will be a change in the calendar for WDL. Going forward, the final WDL event of each year will be at the start of the State Shoot. That way, champions will be determined, and trophies will be awarded at our big event. To make this change, we are having a mini schedule leading up to the 2025 State Shoot, with any clubs having WDL targets from now until July 8, counting as 2025 WDL. Trophies will be awarded to the same classes; it will just be a short extra WDL. After that, going forward, WDL season will start after State Shoot and wind up at the next one the following year. Any club that wants to have a WDL event, please do. The more, the merrier!

Rules to qualify for trophies:

Classification is determined by your beginning average for the year first targets are shot or current average; whichever is higher, including ATA averages if applicable.

PITA 4 class system: A, B, C, D

Must shoot at a minimum of two different clubs.

Must shoot a minimum of eight events (800 targets).

WDL average determined by top eight scores shot

So far for 2025 WDL:

March 28 Yakima (Spring Yak) May 16 Bremerton

June 6 Black Diamond June 20 Wenatchee

July 8 Evergreen (State Shoot)

So far for 2026 WDL:

August 15 Black Diamond August 29 Bremerton

September 12 Yakima (Big Yak)

September 19 Gig Harbor (Seafood Shoot)

October 18 Old Skagit




