Description

The American history course is a fast-moving survey of the story of America from before European contact to the present day, from a primarily Christian perspective. We will examine, compare, and contrast other viewpoints as we discuss the unique themes of American history. We will consider a variety of historical and literary sources, and then analyze them, both in weekly writing assignments and in class discussions of the major eras of American history. The fall semester covers America from before Columbus to the end of the 1800s, and in the spring, we tackle the turbulent 20th century to the present. At the end of the course, your student will have a solid understanding of the historical themes of both the western hemisphere and the United States, in particular.

I look forward to working with your students because history really is His-story, and I am passionate about sharing in the discovery of all He has done and is doing in America and in the world where she has come to hold so much influence.

Tuition & Fees

My class tuition is **\$50 per month per student** if you are paying monthly. There is a nice **discount if you pay for the first semester at registration** and the entire second semester in January. A discount also applies **if you pay for the whole year in August**. **If you decide to remove your student(s) before the end of the semester, tuition for the entire semester is still required.**

There is a supply fee of **\$50 per student** to cover the cost of books and materials, which I will supply, *in addition to the textbook*. The ***textbook must be returned to me at the end of the course*** in order to avoid a replacement cost. If the other materials are returned to me in good, useable condition, there is a partial rebate of the supply fee available.
