

James Patrick Dunn January 4, 1947 - May 24, 2025

James (Jim) Dunn of Caseville passed away peacefully on May 24 after a relentless battle with multiple conditions. He was 78.

Jim was born in Detroit to James and Dorothy Dunn and grew up in St. Clair Shores. He was preceded in death by his parents and older brother Jerry Michael, his son Jim, and son-in-law Patrick.
