## BURGEES

Those triangular shaped little flags hanging in the Crow's nest are *burgees*. A burgee is a flag that bears the colors and/or emblems of a sailing club. It is thought that the word derives from the French word *bourgeois*, which became *burgess* or owner/shipmaster in English and that *burgess*' flag just got shortened to *burgee*. Yacht club burgees are generally triangular or sometimes swallow-tailed in shape, depending on the individual yacht club. Some fleets, like the E-scows also have a burgee, or you might notice some burgees at the KYC commemorate specific events or regattas.

Flag etiquette dictates that you fly your Club burgee from a bow staff on a powerboat. Burgees used to be flown from a sailboat's masthead, but with the advent of electronics now mounted there, the common practice is to fly it from the starboard spreader on a sailboat.

There is a nautical tradition to exchange burgees when visiting other yacht clubs—perhaps your winter 'home' or when attending a regatta. Members traveling to other clubs may purchase burgees in advance! Sophie can assist you as **we do have KYC burgees available from the bar.**
