ELPOA Building Requirements

- 1. ELPOA Building Application must be submitted before any work is started and a permit obtained if ELPOA Board approves
- 2. Certificate of Occupancy required before occupancy allowed
- 3. Any structure 120 square feet needs an Owen County Building Permit
- 4. Lots shall be used for residential purposes only
- 5. No more than one single family dwelling house on any one lot
- 6. No more than one other building for storage or garage purposes
- 7. No accessory or temporary building shall be used as living quarters
- 8. No structures shall have tar paper, roll brick siding, or similar material on the outside walls
- 9. All buildings must be completed within six (6) months from the date construction commences
- 10.No porch or projections shall extend nearer than twenty (20) feet from any road right of way
- 11. No porch or projection shall extend nearer than ten (10) feet from the property line of any abutting property owner
- 12.No porch or projection shall extend fifty (50) feet from the normal high water line of Elk Lake
- 13. No outside toilets
- 14.No drain field or other disposal system shall be allowed nearer than sixty (60) feet from the normal high water line of Elk Lake
- 15. No new open or lagoon type drain fields are allowed
- 16.Portable toilets for new construction may be acceptable per prior written permission from the ELPOA Board
- 17.No residence shall have less than six hundred (600) square feet of living space on the ground or first floor, exclusive of porch area.
- 18.No residence shall have less than one thousand (1000) square feet of living space exclusive of the porch, garage, deck and unfinished basement areas
- 19.The maximum size of a dwelling shall be determined by the septic and related sanitary disposal system requirements
- 20. Maximum size of a permanent storage as part of a dock system without a permanent residence is six (6) feet by eight (8) feet
- 21. Dock storage structures shall be cedar or other high quality siding
- 22. Dock storage structures shall be shingled or metal commercial grade roof
- 23.No docks shall extend nearer than ten (10) feet from the property line of any abutting property owner
- 24. No dock or any structure shall extend further than twenty (20) feet into the water from the normal high water line of Elk Lake
