

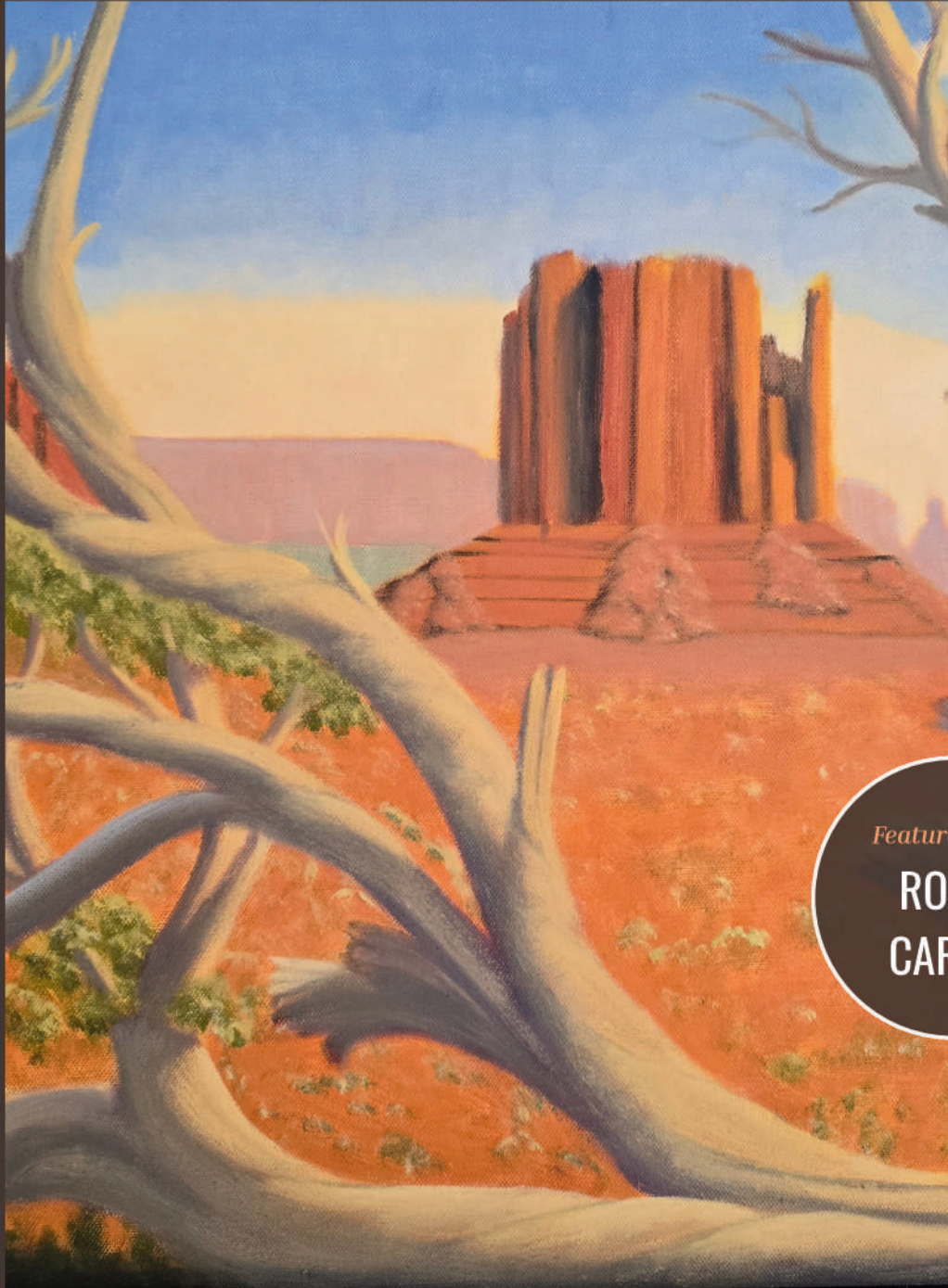

Featured Artist: Roger Carver

As a naturalist at heart, the landscape is the perfect vehicle for expressing the joy I have for the world that surrounds me. My interest as a painter is how to best use the core principles of painting and transform the results into effective visual statements. I'm most successful when I'm able to communicate that joy to the viewers of my paintings.

A compelling love for the mountains and their changing moods and seasons has drawn me into the high country of Colorado, and Rocky Mountain West. I strive to capture the quality of light in the high country and transform the blank canvas into a living memory of the experience.

I am basically a naturalistic/ representational painter and I am attracted first by the contrast of light and shadows, colors, and then by textures and detail.

My struggle is to find a balance among those elements. It is something I am always working towards as I seek to capture some of the detail that interests me and that provides context for the viewer.

In landscape paintings, it's that fleeting moment in time and the feeling of the light and air that I strive most to capture. I want the viewer to feel as though they are experiencing that moment in time and place.

My goal is to capture the truth about the subject without over embellishment of the main idea - the feeling of being there in the light and air.

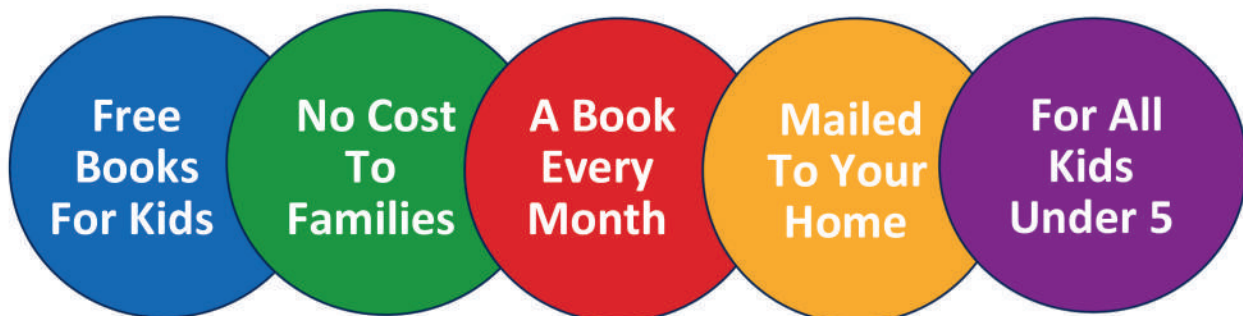

- Over 5000 kids under 5 live in Broomfield
- 18% of the books are either fully bilingual Spanish-English or include Spanish-language content.
- 85% of the books include parent reading tips and activities.
- Rotary offers the Imagination Library to all children under 5 in Broomfield.
- Broomfield Rotary and the State of Colorado pay approximately \$25.00 per year for each child enrolled in the library.

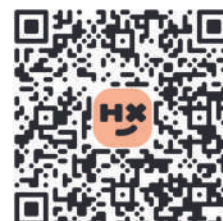

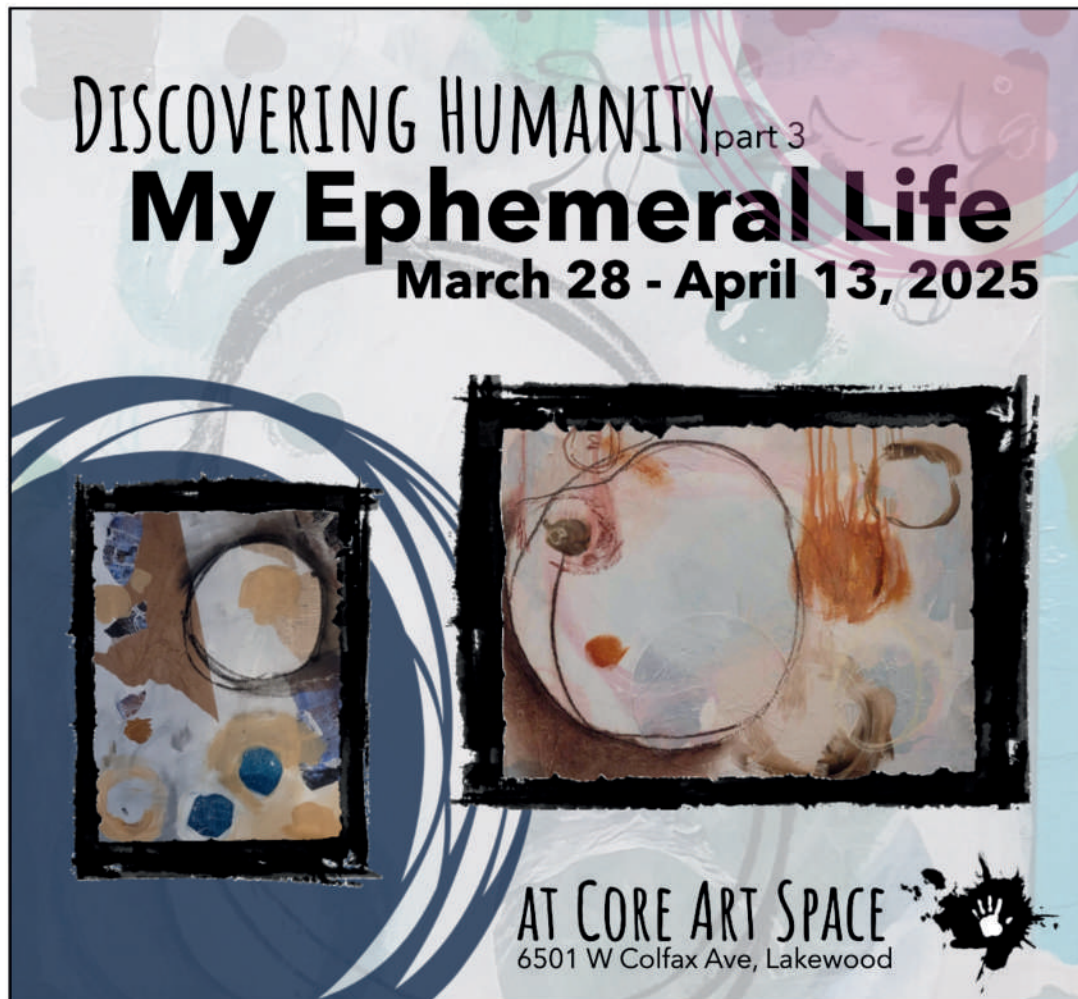
In our spring concert, Rocky Mountain Brassworks takes a look at the lighter side of music.

Discovering Humanity Part III: My Ephemeral Life

By Camie Rigrozzi

In this show, bits and pieces of Broomfield artist Camie Rigrozzi's art are gathered and reused in another context. Her present work preserves parts of her experience, and releases what she has made peace with in acknowledgement of her empty hole. Edges of curved forms are not sharp, and emotions tumbled in the consciousness lose their rough edges. Round and round the canvas, fitting pieces into space, she covers past emotions until one large, *Imperfect Whole* connects the fragments.

"When people view this work, I hope they can feel the ecstasy of letting go of judgement, embracing acceptance, and making peace with their own *Imperfect Whole*."
