GET A JUMP START, PLAN YOUR XERISCAPE GARDEN NOW

Plan and design carefully for water conservation. Planning xeriscape designs requires careful consideration of many factors, including not only water requirements, but budget, function, aesthetics, and expected maintenance, both now and in the future.

Reduce turf grass and other water wasting plants. Planning xeriscape designs doesn't mean you have to give up the idea of a lush, green lawn. However, because it demands huge amounts of water, lawns should be kept to a minimum and should consist of drought-tolerant grass appropriate for your area. Consider replacing part or all of your lawn with low-water groundcovers or other lawn alternatives, which are drought-tolerant and usually require little or no fertilizer, insecticides, or herbicides.

Waste Water 101

Think Vertically. It arrived last week. The HUBER vertical, self cleaning screen will save time and money.

Pumps in lift stations require a lot of maintenance. Pumps with a large clear passage are used to prevent frequent clogging. However, those pumps have poor efficiency, particularly where the flow is low. Grinder pumps are subject to high wear, thus also requiring frequent maintenance in a narrow and dangerous environment. Upstream screening protects pumps from clogging and permits use of high-efficiency pumps. In addition, removal of coarse solids protects sewers by preventing deposits and reducing septicity, odor and concrete corrosion.



The RoK 4 screen vertically lifts the screenings, and dewater and compacts them at the same time. The compacted screenings are discharged into a container or endless bagger for further disposal thus eliminating odour nuisance and pump failure due to clogging.
