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#### Our Family Christmas 2016 By Wade Anderson

Hello everyone! Here we are, Christmas 2016 and another year has come and gone. To some time drags on where others, like myself, the days, weeks and years seem to get shorter and shorter. But the one thing I can assure us all is, each and every one of us has the same 24 hours in a single day as every other person alive. So that in its self should draw us ALL to be more aware of the urgency, to the best of our ability, to have as many of our minutes count for the glory of God.

Time is the one thing that once it's gone we never get it back. Similar to money we can waste, spend or invest our time. What do I mean? Think about this. When we've wasted our money or time we have nothing to show for what we 'had'. Most times, when we've 'spent' our money or time we at least have something to show for it. But when we 'invest' our money or time this process usually brings with it a greater return. So what am I saying? God showed me that if I would intentionally 'invest' some of the 24 hours that He has given me into people, He would guarantee me a greater return on that time. In other words, if we are willing to 'invest' however many of our own 24 hours sharing Jesus, encouraging and building others up He will return that 'investment' back to us in things that money can buy and things that money cannot buy! What we've actually done is we've given that person or those people a certain portion of our own life. And let me assure you, there is even a definite difference between 'spending' and 'investing' time with someone. Let me ask you all this. How much of your 24 hours are you willing to 'invest' into those there around you? How much has someone else already 'invested' in you? If God wishes that not even one should perish (*2 Peter 3:9*) and He has already 'invested' His best for you how much are you willing to 'invest' in to helping someone else secure their eternity in heaven??! Jesus tells us, in *John 15:13, "Greater lave laws me and things that be lay down like like law down like like laws and self-centeredness,* 'invest' of yourself and learn to help each other."

When God created each and every one of us He had three specific things in mind. The first thing was love. John 3:16-17 (Message) shows us that, "This is how much God loved the world: He gave His Son, His One and only Son. And this is why: so that no one need to be destroyed; by believing in Him, anyone can have a whole and loading life." As we read in Romans 5:8, "... God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners." Knowing firsthand the lifestyle that we've lived against God, many of us may struggle with why God would give His only Son for the person we once were. Just like so many others at one point I wondered this myself. There is no way any of us can ever fully comprehend this level of love. But as we continue on this adventure with God, reading His Word and drawing closer to Him in our prayer life the more we begin to feel His love pour over us with a deeper revelation of love. Don't forget that God knows the beginning from the end and the potential He has placed inside of each of us. In other words, it's not so much how we started but more importantly how we finish.

And that leads me to the second and third things God created us for ... relationship and family. Back in 2007, when God gave me this vision for this newsletter I felt Him say to me, "You'll never be lonely again." At that time I never really understood what that truly meant. I already had a family that loved me. And quite frankly they were waiting for me to be more engaged with them than I had been. My family hadn't given up on me even though I was wearing them all very thin in many areas. I see today that their love for me then, in a sense, kind of held them in limbo with their own lives.

As this major change in my life was underway, about 7 to 9 months in, while holding Michelle's hands and praying one morning something came over me so intensely. As we stood there I gripped her hands even tighter and with tears rolling down my face I said, "I've never asked you to forgive me of the things I'd done or been a part of, until now." As she looked right in my eyes she said, "I never held it against you. I knew the day would come that our lives would turn completely around." I am not lying to anyone, at that point I broke down even more. Please believe me when I say that I am in no way comparing Michelle to God but it was through her unconditional love that began to open my eyes even wider to the greater level of love that God must also have for us all. Love is a great motivator!

In Genesis Chapter 1:1-25, God created the heavens and the earth, day and night, water and land, vegetation and every seed bearing plant, the moon and the stars, every fish in the ocean and bird in the sky, and every living creature and wild animal. God did all of this in a very specific order. Why? Because He was about to create His most precious of creations, man and woman. God created Adam for relationship with Himself. After Adam's creation God looked at him and said, "It is not good for man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him." (Genesis 2:18) After Adam had named all of the animals God seen that there was not a suitable helper for him so He caused Adam to fall into a deep sleep, took one of Adam's ribs from his side and created woman. (Genesis 2:19-22) Why did I say all of this? To show that "... God created man in His own image, in the image of Him He created him; male and female He created them." (Genesis 1:27) NOTHING else that God created is more precious to Him than you and I. In fact after God created the woman, Eve, He never created anything else. God made us out of His love; for relationship ... to be His eternal family.

By Genesis Chapter 3, Adam and Eve had already been deceived. They were the only ones that walked in the Garden of Eden in the cool of the day and heard God's voice and still they were tricked. The deceiver, satan, thought he had torn apart what God had made to be so special. That is when God said, "And I will put enmity (hatred and hostility) between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; He will crush your head, and you will strike His heel." (Genesis 3:15)

God had just set in motion a plan to bring us ALL back to Him. The woman's 'Offspring' would be Jesus! This verse pointed to the Cross, on the other side of the Cross. In the grave Jesus DID crush satan's head and DID triumph over him as He resurrected. In Colossians 2:15 we read, "In this way, He disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by His victory on the cross." It is so important that we know the victory is NOW ours, "And you have been made complete in Christ, who is the head over every ruler and authority." (Colossians 2:10) "This is how much God loved the world: He gave His Son, His One and only Son. And this is why: so that no one be destroyed; by balleving in Him, ANYONE can have a whole and leading IDs." (John 3:16 Message) All of this has been God's master plan ... to restore us to His family!

Even though our first newsletter was printed and sent to 35 people, within the first 6 months the mailing list had grown to close to 75 people. That was when I began to realize just what God meant when He said, "You'll never be lonely again." What was happening? God was building His family through relationship. It was through the mail that kept pouring in day after day that I started to see what God meant. As God began placing each and every one of you in my new life it became easier and easier for me NOT to listen to the lies the devil had flooded me with for so many years. The more I listened to God's direction for my life and stayed focused on answering your letters the easier those old familiar places and faces seem to fade away. I was no longer feeling that false sense of loneliness that used to attack my emotions, causing me to gravitate back to that same ole vomit. What I'm saying here is this. Right before my eyes I was watching as God was powerfully moving from one heart to another! As God began to build this ministry we seen that He was more importantly building a family, His family, His body, the church. The whole vision/mission to send hope, love and encouragement became increasingly evident that these three things were exactly what so many of us had lost sight of and chased after for so long in our lives. As the mail continued to flood our desk here my own heart began to ache for so many of you as the letters revealed over and over again the loss of family in your lives. That's when I truly recognized that the Ørxrowntre for Øfriet was growing into something much more than a newsletter. We were growing together in God's Word and He was raising us up as the Ørxrowntre for §friet family!!

Being the December issue some of you may be wondering what all of this has to do with Christmas. Well, it's Christmas time that we celebrate the birth of Jesus. That's when God sent His Son into the world as the Christ child, conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. All of this took place and fulfilled the prophecy in *Isaiah 7:14*, "*The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.*" - which means "*God with us.*" (*Matthew 1:23*) It's all relevant.

Being transparent I'll close with this ...Through the years I've wondered where my walk with Jesus might have been if He hadn't brought us all together. All of us here feel this way so we do our best to keep it real and keep it Jesus! This is why we often say and believe, "WE NEED EACH OTHER!!" From your Overcenters for Officient family here ... We wish ALL of you a very **MERRY CHRISTMAS**, filled with the joy of the Lord!

# Vrayer Requests

I'm here in California because when I was in New York my two sons, Jorge Jr. and Jose, moved to Texas and California. Jorge Jr. went to Texas with my sister and now has a family of five of his own. Jose was in the US Navy and when he got out he moved here. I missed my sons so much that I came out

here to be with him. After 6 months, I was accused of a crime. My lawyers all sold me out and helped the D.A. win the case against me. My Appellant Attorney also sold me out and only submitted two sentencing issues in my direct appeal. And me, as I did my research for eight years found that the Judge committed judicial misconduct, the D.A. didn't just commit

prosecutorial misconduct but committed the crime of subordination of perjury by inducing the witness to commit perjury on the stand. I have to file a writ of habeas corpus and prove all this, only I don't have the skills to put a writ of habeas corpus together. People want too much money to do that, and I can't afford it. I'm only hoping that you have everyone pray that whoever does one for me will do a good one and help me get a reversal and allow me to go back to New York to care for my elderly mother who lives alone. I want to make it home before she dies on me. So please, if you all pray as I do we can be in agreement and the Lord will hear our prayers. I have been saved since 1984 and I know the Word of God. I just have a bad memory problem due to a long time of drug use. But I have faith! I know God will work it out for me. God Bless in Yeshua's name ... J.R.

I'm getting this letter off to you as fast as I can write. I'm truly in need of some prayer support if you don't mind. I am a guy that needs the Lord to take over the problems I am facing in my life. First, that I remain with my thoughts, heart, mind, body and soul on God. Second, for God to take control of this pay problem at my work. Third, for me to find an address for me to parole to in 8 1/2 months. Fourth, for a better job in and out of prison. Fifth, to remain strong in the Spirit and be able to hear His voice through all of this madness going on in my life. # Praise Reports

Hope you all are doing great, physically, mentally, and spiritually. Thank God I'm blessed and standing firm in His Word. I recently gave my life to our Lord ... got baptized June 3, 2016. It's been a new walk for me! I'm 35 now, and mostly all

my life I've been dedicated to a life of crime and all that follows behind. But since my baptism, I've become a whole new person! Something I never thought of doing ... especially in prison! I've been down on this new term for six years in December. I still got 18 years more to do. But before I gave my life to Christ, I was going through some hardships in my life with personal family issues, my brother was murdered in

November of 2010, my incarceration in December 2010 which led to my sentence of 25 years, and last but not least, my lil' daughter was put in child protective services on three different occasions due to her mother being around

negative activity. My daughter is six years old now. But I started to attend church here in February of 2015, and went three times a week, and I still attend three days a week. I prayed and prayed for all those issues in my life to mend and to bring peace, joy and no more worries. God started answering prayer after prayer!! Amen!!! God's done enough for me and is still working in my life. My daughter is now with my mother legally. I'm finally going to meet my daughter for the first time in six years. My mom is bringing her to visit. She was only ten months when I got locked up. So, I thank God for all He's done in my life. I can only repay Him by being obedient to Him!! God's good ... S.L.

As I read the cards you sent I feel so blessed to have such amazing people in my life, or should I say "a gift from God", that has never met me but through your words it seems like you have known me all of my life. Thank you!! I pray for the

Overcomers for Efrist and in case you don't know, you all bring God's Light into a place of darkness or as I call it "the devil's playground" and show God's love when I feel lost and it helps me to know I am found. When I feel like no one cares you write me and it shows me how truly blessed I am. All glory be to God above for what all of you do for this hurting soul and all the other lives you touch with His kindness and caring ... C.H.

I just recently accepted Jesus Christ into my heart and I do believe God sent His Son and that Jesus died on the Cross for our sins and was resurrected three days later. I've been Asatru since 2009 but I'm now a Christian and I thank God that He opened my eyes. I have about 3.5 years left out of a 6.5 year sentence. I ask you to pray for me as a newbie in faith and also for my mom, sister, brother and grandma. The Apostle Paul, I think of him when I think of the miracle being performed in me. Saul, whose name was later changed to Paul, who was on a mission to hunt down Christians, was found by Christ. Paul, like myself, was full of arrogance and misguided, but God saw something else, something greater in Paul, and in me likewise. I do not consider myself to be as great a godly man as the Apostle Paul following his miraculous conversion. I mean, wow, Paul was chosen to write over two-thirds of the New Testament of God's Holy Word. God told Ananias that Paul, when he was still Saul and misguided that he was a chosen vessel. What a wonderful and miraculous thing! That God could see and deal with and bring a man such as that to a place of redemption and purpose. And not just an ordinary purpose but a purpose for the Living God! One thing I can relate to when I compare myself to the Apostle Paul is when Paul referred to himself as being the chief of sinners, for I know how truly awfully sinful that I and my sins once were. When I think about it I am amazed at how God could see anything of value in me, let alone forgive me of such sinful and horrible transgressions, but God did. As the Apostle Paul once was, I too am in prison. The difference is that I am here for a crime that I committed and for laws that I broke while I was still in sin and unsaved. I have been locked up since June of 2006. The remarkable thing is that just as God did with Saul, the Apostle Paul, God too has done more with my life and used me more in prison than what I ever could have been purposed for, before being broken and humbled.

Does God want anyone to go through such unfortunate events? No! God has a perfect will for each of us. Unfortunately, many of us don't willingly seek after God's perfect will for our lives. So God, in His great mercy comes along in the midst of the mess we have made of our life and turns it into something good for His glory, because He is so very good, merciful and perfectly patient. I must honestly say that I do not like my current situation, being imprisoned at all! I also must say that I in no way blame God for my imprisonment, for I know that I am imprisoned because of sin and my choices. But instead, I praise God! Not because of my unpleasant circumstances but because through them God has helped bring me to Himself. How wonderful and merciful is God, that He would pursue a sinful man like me! That is truly perfect patience and love, at the lowest point in my life, when I was broken into pieces and my whole life was shattered, God gently reached down with love and picked me up. Praise God for His wonderful goodness! God's love is so amazing and beyond comprehension! Since January of 2007, the Living God has been using me to tell others of His goodness.

Not only is Jesus the Author of my faith but He is also the Author of everything. So even in the worst of situations, sitting in a 7x12 prison cell, possibly facing a day in the future when my day may come, God is still perfectly capable of performing a daily purpose with what is left of me and my life. Personally, just as the Apostle Paul spent his remaining earth days in prison, I too may very well do the same, though not as great a man of God as the Apostle Paul. I am still certain and convinced of this one thing, that God through His infinite wisdom has truly performed a miracle concerning me, and His purpose for me, though I allowed sin to cast me and my life down, God loved me enough though I was completely destroyed! God, through Jesus Christ my Savior redeemed my eternal soul and saved me from eternal death and hell. This is God's miracle in me. Just read the Word. Amen!!

The Lord Jesus Christ knows what is best for us, and He has good intentions for us. His thoughts about us are in the light of eternity and not just our limited perspective. I would willingly suffer a lifetime to spend eternity with the Lord. The Bible is full of examples of people who suffered for their faith, and suffering tends to purify our faith and motives for everything. Suffering helps us to simplify life and focus on what is really important. It unclutters our soul. Hardships truly do shape our character. A man stands or falls on character. Suffering makes us bitter or better. There is nothing quite like the gravity of anointing and wisdom that comes from a man who has suffered much and chosen to be better, instead of worse.

As I have studied Scripture most of my life, it does not take a brain surgeon to see that the Scriptures all point to and proclaim that Jesus is our Messiah.

# Foot's Bible Study Rotes

# 1 Chronicles 22:1-26:11

God can use our sins for good purposes if we are sorry for them and seek His forgiveness. When we confess our sins, the way is opened for God to bring good from a bad situation. (22:1)

No matter what place of service you have in the church, you are important to the healthy functioning of the congregation. (23:28-32)

As we read we find that there were many ways to contribute to the worship in the tabernacle. Some proclaimed God's messages (25:1), some offered thanks in praise (25:3), and others played instruments (25:6-7). The same holds true in our churches of today, God wants all His people to participate in worship. You may not be a master musician, a prophet, or a teacher, but God appreciates whatever you have to offer. Develop your special gifts to offer in service to God (Romans 12:3-8, 1 Corinthians 12:29-31). (25:1-7)

## Romans 3:9-4:12

After all this bad news about our sinfulness and God's condemnation, Paul gives the wonderful news. There is a way to be declared not guilty - by trusting Jesus Christ to take away our sins. Trusting means putting our confidence in Christ to forgive our sins, to make us right with God, and to empower us to live the way He taught us. God's solution is available to all of us regardless of our background or past behavior. (3:21-29)

This verse means that if a person could earn right standing with God by being good, the granting of that gift wouldn't be a free act. It would be an obligation. Our self-reliance is futile, all we can do is cast ourselves on God's mercy and grace. (4:4)

Ceremonies and rituals serve as reminders of our faith as well as instruct new or young believers. But we should not think that they give us any special merit before God. They are outward signs and seals that demonstrate inner belief and trust. The focus of our faith should be on Christ and His saving work, not on our own actions. (4:10-12)

### Psalm 11:1-13:6

Faith in God keeps us from losing hope and helps us resist fear. David's advisers were afraid because they saw only frightening circumstances and crumbling foundations. David was comforted and optimistic because he knew God was greater than anything his enemies could bring against him. (11:1-4)

We may believe that lies are relatively harmless, or even useful at times. But God does not overlook lies, flattery, deception or boasting. Each of these sins originates from a bad attitude that is eventually expressed in our speech. The tongue can be our greatest enemy because, though small, it can do great damage. (*James 3:5-6*) Be careful how you use yours. (12:2-4)

Sometimes all we need to do is talk over a problem with a friend to help put it in perspective. In this Psalm, the phrase "how long" occurs four times in the first two verses, indicating the depth of David's distress. David expressed his feelings to God and found strength. By the end of his prayer, he was able to express hope and trust in God. Through prayer, we can express our feelings and talk our problems out with God. He helps us regain the right perspective, and gives us peace (*Habakkuk 3:17-19*). (*13:1*)

### Proverbs 19:13-16

Continual dripping speaks of constant dissention within a family. A prudent wife is a woman who demonstrates wisdom or skill. Finding the right spouse is a blessing from God. (19:13-14)

The commandments we are told to obey are those found in God's Word, such as the Ten Commandments (*Exodus 20*) and other passages of instruction. To obey what God teaches in the Bible is self-persevering. To disobey is self-destructive.

I know I can say these things to you and you take no glory in any of it; instead you see it as it is, hopeful encouragement. Brother, from within you glows the truth of Jesus Christ, crucified and risen, and His message of Salvation through forgiveness of sins. The love of our Father shines brightest among the true men and women of God willingly and gratefully that serve the kingdom of Christ for the glory of our Creator in heaven! Your righteous words and deeds are noticed because they're so different from this selfish lifestyle that's typical of the world - the Narcissism so common in the American culture. There are a multitude who see your light shine forth and want Jesus Christ, the Living God, for themselves.

Reflecting the light of Christ is our primary God given job, and so we must fulfill this eternal obligation each day by 'Seeking' the Lord with ALL we are, our whole hearts. 'Submitting' our old selves, consistently and persistently to His power and authority over us. 'Serving' the Lord and fulfilling the Father's purpose - His perfect plan for each of His grateful sons and daughters! This is the greatest honor we will ever have in this life, and there's always someone in our sphere of influence who will need the lantern we have inside of us to shine and guide them towards the true Light of the world ... ALL for the Glory and the Honor of Almighty God! Praise the Lord!

I understand all too well the concept of being overwhelmed with 'things' to do. When I find myself 'too busy' with 'things' on my plate, I stop and reread the story of Mary and Martha. It was only after Jesus had raised their brother Lazarus from the dead that Martha finally understood the awesome power of Christ. There is nothing we can do to honor Him sufficiently, yet He gladly receives all things done for Him with a heart of gratitude. Mary's heart of devotion placed her at the feet of Jesus, humbling herself before the Almighty God, while cherishing the words of our Lord. To the living God be ALL Praise and Glory! Praise the Coming King!

By the time this message is revealed to the rest of the Stationary for Sfirit family in the Christmas issue of the newsletter, I will probably have already been able to visit you in person! Why? Because I was accepted by the 'Church on the Street' at the Dream Center in Phoenix. They are the only spiritual half-way house that would accept me. It is the will of God! And as always I bow in

grateful surrender and simply avow, "Not my way, ABBA, Your will be done." I go to the board here in the next few days and God willing, I'll be approved. I feel as though I have done everything here that He has asked me to do. Is there any other way for a true man or woman of God to respond! YAHOO! I think not!

I hear there has been a slight change or two that's taken place these past 30 years. Ha! Ha! But I'm sure there are still motorcycles to ride and wide open roads to ride them on. My plan is to 'Ride for Christ' when I'm off of parole next year. I'm going to travel those roads and bring the 'Light of Christ' to other outlaws and critters. Of course, the Lord may have another 'path of light', and I've learned to embrace His grace and enjoy His 'Plan A'.

Here's My Little Story, It's Short By A.A.

Greetings brothers and sisters of the Overcomers for Shrist! First I wish to tell you a little story, it is short.

For about six months, I've been picking up copies of your newsletter off of the table that our microwave sits on. The newsletter is very well put together and spiritually grown. Even though I would read them I don't always react to all literature I see just laying around in here. I'd been praying on it and about it. Mind you I've never seen anyone of color in any of your newsletters UNTIL your January 2016 issue. So this time I said, "Okay, here's a black face, so it's obviously not only for whites. They are Christians and not a biker club or something like that." So, continuing to pray about it I felt a nudging to write this letter.

I write to a lot of churches and Christian organizations most of which never write me back. But I don't get upset I merely pray for them and keep doing me. You know, 'If it doesn't kill you it will only make you stronger, right?' I do all of the Bible studies I can and write whoever will listen. I'm only out to learn all that I can of our Lord. I have brothers from Rescued Not Arrested Ministry I've written to for over three years and they have truly been heaven send to me!

Please don't be offended by this next statement but it is also a big part of doing time. But, being who I am or the color of skin I was born into and people don't look at you the same, Christian or not, I love me and mine and mine be other believers in Christ Jesus. The Word teaches me to love even those who hate me, AMEN?! In order for me to stay right with God I must do what He commands me and not follow man's lead right?

Now back to your newsletter ... It is filled with Scriptures, prayers and poems and has always uplifted me on some of my most gray days. So this has led me to write you this letter to let you know of the job your newsletter is doing for the greater good. I usually don't write much as I get tongue tied and I don't get out my true meaning. I am a 50 year old black man with not much education but I've gotten better through writing letters to my mentor.

I have spent 30 plus years inside prison walls and gates. I know a lot about the prison life, but when it comes to living outside and free in the streets, I'm at a loss. I've written to a few transitional living residences and I would like to ask that you all join me in prayer, that one of them would write me back and it would be the right fit.

Another thing that hit me about these issues of your newsletter was, I enjoyed how it looks as if you all are one big happy family sitting around the table reading and answering letters! Thank you to all those at the Glory Meeting of the Overcomers for Striet.

He gently touched the flawless cheek of our son. He looked back to us after only a moment, and with tears on his cheeks, mumbled, "God bless you," then grabbed his shopping cart and walked on. It was in that moment Christmas finally became real. It was more than lights, packages, and songs; it was the brokenness of mankind answered with the offered hope of a newborn child.
