- Acts 6:1–7 They chose Stephen.
- Psalm 33 “Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you.”
- 1 Peter 2:4–9 “The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone.”
- John 14:1–12 “I am the way and the truth and the life.”

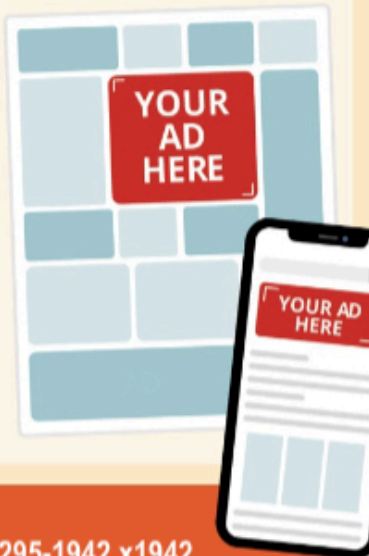
