<p>Evaluation Report</p> <p>How the Early Years Pupil Premium was spent</p> <p>The nursery was closed to the majority of children from 23/03/2020 due to the current Covid-19 situation, therefore expenditure has been reduced. The underspend (£2,895.38) will be carried forward to 2020-21.</p> <p>This funding went towards supporting development and removing barriers to learning in all areas of the EYFS and narrowing the gap between EYPP and non EYPP in attainment and progress.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resources to support communication and language with a focus on speaking £132.79 • Theatre Group £800.00 • Contributing towards the cost school uniform for children in receipt of EYPP £349.36 • Contributing towards the cost of staffing to support small group work £4,000

Evaluation of Impact of Additional Funding

- Enabled all children to take full advantage of all areas of provision within nursery, ensuring full access to all learning and enrichment opportunities.
- Additional resources targeted at speaking, maths, reading and writing have helped remove barriers to learning and supported a large majority of children to make more than 2 steps of progress in these areas. (Only 2+ due to Covid-19).
