### Ongoing Daily Activities:

**Pillar Of Kindness:** students/staff to write thank you notes and positive quotes to show appreciation to each other.

**Staff Shout Out- Student to Staff – Shout out box will be at Front Office Window:** Students write down your shout outs for staff members or solicit nominations from other students in the school, they will be read at morning/afternoon announcements for the whole school to hear.

**Random Acts of Kindness:** You see someone being Kind? Going out of their way to make a difference in someone else's life? Please nominate students by writing the child's name and how they showed kindness. Then all of the nominated students will be entered into a weekly drawing for a prize. One prize for Prek-2<sup>nd</sup>, 3rd-5<sup>th</sup>, and another for Middle School. The students/staff drop the nominations off to the Random Acts of Kindness Box at Front Office.

**Secret Kindness Missions-** Students your mission is to do something kind for a specific person all week, but Shhh keep it a secret! Let your students know that there are Top Secret Mission Cards at the table in front of the Pillar of Kindness. Use the decoder to assist with Secret Kindness Missions this week! Teachers you may assign a person or simply have your students pick another student or staff member that they want to show kindness too. Have fun with it!

\*Teachers may create an age appropriate assignment for students to journal, write a paper, or document their secret missions for the week. Include how it made them feel and what they can do moving forward to keep kindness going in the community.

**Kindness notes in hymnals-** have students write out kindness messages to parishoners to find in their hymnals.
