DESCRIPTION: The RARE Wambaw was the last entry into the Shakespeare bow line. It was introduced in 1975 and made during 75 and part of 1976 until Shakespeare decided to close its archery division that year. Like other Shakespeare models, the Wambaw is a great looking and performing recurve. Factory installed stabilizer insert. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. 2 filled screw holes on the side of the riser (see pic last page). No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; the Shakespeare logo is in excellent original condition; the Wambaw model decal is a reproduction. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.

Comes with a new string and Shakespeare arrow rest as shown.
