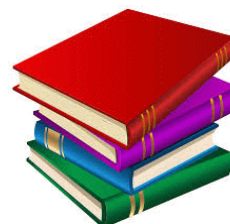
Now in its 6th year, our chapter's Summer Camp Program continues with varied and interesting activities for you to participate in - with friends you know and friends you haven't yet met!

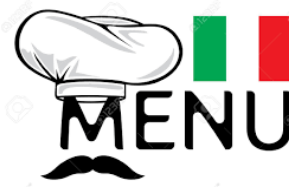

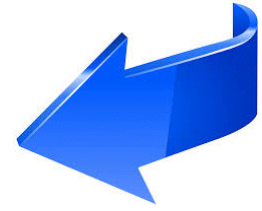

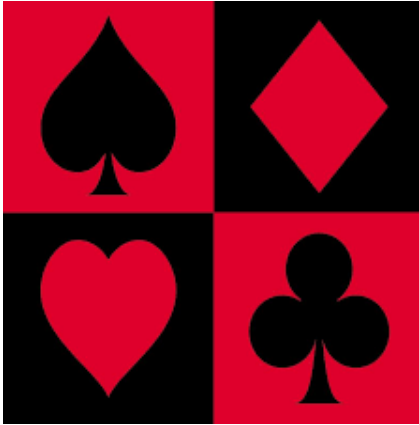

The National Center for Jewish Film's annual festival will feature limited release screenings, regional premieres and insightful discussions from May 2 to 13.

Professor of American Studies Thomas Doherty, Adjunct Associate Professor of Jewish Film, along with Executive Director of the NCJF Sharon Pucker Rivo, and Hadassah-Brandeis Institute Research Associate Dalia Wassner, will participate in post-screening film talks during the festival.

Additionally, many of the events are being sponsored or presented by Brandeis organizations. Founded in 1976, The National Center for Jewish Film is an independent non-profit organization with its offices located on the Brandeis campus. It features more than 15,000 reels of feature films, documentaries, newsreels, home movies and institutional films date from 1903 to the present.

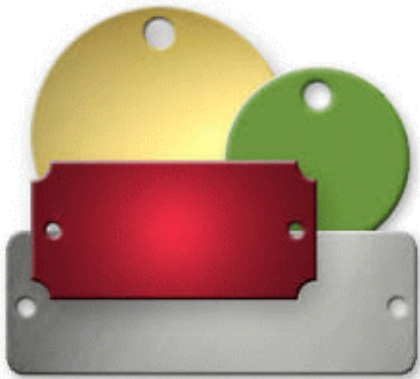

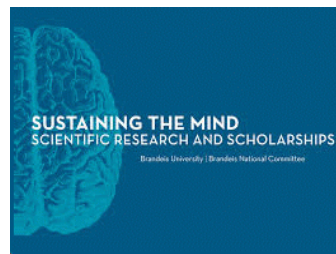
