HARLEY R. ANDREWS, Bad Axe — News was received of the unexpected death Tuesday in Clearwater, Fla., of Harley R. Andrews, 52, former resident of Bad Axe and World War II veteran. Mr. Andrews was an electrical contractor in Bad Axe and was also in that business in Florida. The family moved about 13 years ago to Florida. Born June 5, 1912, in Grant Township, Huron County, Mr. Andrews spent his boyhood there. He entered the Army Jan. 30, 1942, and served three years in the European Theater with the Military Police. He was an unsuccessful candidate for the Republican nomination for sheriff of Huron County in 1950. His widow is the former Miss Helen Adams, also a former resident of Bad Axe. He is also survived by his daughter, Joy, and a son, Jay, who live with their parents; his mother, Mrs. Elizabeth Andrews; and two brothers, Elmer and Edwin Andrews, all of Owendale. Funeral services and burial will be held at Clearwater Friday.
