From the Pastor's Desk...

Resuming in-person worship has been heavy on my mind, as I'm sure it has been for you too. As places of worship and businesses have begun to open up in our area, the church has been asked about when we might resume in-person worship, and the standard answer has been "we don't know." While this is still true, we are also working towards a time in mid-August when we will resume in-person worship, outside in the courtyard, on Sunday mornings. There is still more conversation to be had and plans/protocols to put in place before we do so but we are engaged and working towards a date. We will share the specific date as we draw closer to August and discern whether we continue with these initial plans or need to adjust, depending on recommendations from health officials and our Synodical leadership.

It has been an unfamiliar time these past few months and with each passing day, the unfamiliar grows in familiarity. And yet, we all make adjustments as necessary and continue to look forward to returning to some once familiar aspects of our life. Worship and various activities/events at church are some of those longed-for familiar things we've been missing. As we continue to work towards providing these opportunities in confidence for all of you, I have been preparing for these days for some time, at least in my mind. Now that movement is going to paper, with other people's input and approval.

All of this reminds me of the season of Advent (the 4 Sundays before Christmas), for Advent is a season of preparation and expectation. While Advent 2020 is still months away, I can't help but be reminded of what it means to prepare in the context of church. In Advent, we are preparing for the birth of Christ; in this current "Advent" that I'm experiencing, I'm preparing to welcome you back to the church building...for we have still been the church in this time, we are still the body of Christ, the family of God...it has not been the same for sure and honestly, things will look and feel different for some time but preparing to gather in-person for worship will be a welcome step to the familiar. Take some time to prepare in your own way, prepare your heart and mind, and pray for those who are working towards this goal. We all need to prepare in our own way and know that there are folks preparing to welcome you to the building of Bethlehem Lutheran. In these summer months, I am experiencing a new Advent and preparing in new and different ways. I invite you to experience this new Advent with me.

In-Person Worship Update: As of the publishing date of this newsletter, here are our thoughts on resuming in-person worship. We are working on plans and protocols so that we can gather for outside, modified, in-person worship. We are hoping to have plans and protocols in place and approved so that we can begin gathering for Sunday morning worship in mid-August. We are planning on modified worship services at 10 am on Sunday mornings, outside in the courtyard. More details will follow in a direct letter to you once things have been approved and established and we have set a date.

All of this is subject to change, depending on the directives and recommendations for our area, what the trends are in our community, and the decisions of our congregational leadership. We will continue to closely monitor advisement from local and state health officials, as well as our Synodical leadership. We are being careful and considerate in our planning and want to ensure safe and healthy opportunities for people to gather for worship, we have all missed being together and we hope that we will be able to see one another again soon. Stay tuned for more updates on the church website, church Facebook page, e-mail, and postal service...we will be using all of these platforms to inform you of the processes we will observe so that we can worship together in-person with confidence that we are doing everything we can to ensure a safe space to gather. We will continue to offer an online worship opportunity for those who do not yet feel comfortable gathering for in-person worship.

In-Person Worship Survey: As part of our planning for resuming in-person worship, we are asking for your feedback in a survey that will be sent out in the coming days. The survey will be asking questions to help us gauge your interest and comfort level in returning for in-person worship. A survey will be sent out via e-mail and for those who don't utilize e-mail, a survey will be mailed out, asking that you return it to the church. We value your input as we make these important decisions and we appreciate your participation.

Weekly Zoom Check-In Meetings continue on Wednesdays at 7:00 pm. This is open for anyone who would like to participate in a fairly brief time of checking in with one another to see and hear from one another, share in a Scripture passage, and spend some time in prayer. You can be a part of these meetings as your schedule allows, so you don't have to feel as though you are committed to participate every week. This is a great opportunity to "see and hear" from one another on a regular basis in this time of physical distancing.
