

HERA (NEUMAN) JOHNSON

1917 - 1995

Hera N. Johnson, 78, a native of Sebawang and for many years a resident of Warren, died Sunday, May 28, following a brief illness.

She was born in Sebawang Feb. 10, 1917, the daughter of Bruno and Minnie (Dressler) Neuman. Her father was custodian of Immanuel Lutheran Church and School, and their family home was at the nearby southwest corner of the M-25/Sebawang Road intersection.

Mrs. Johnson attended Immanuel School and was graduated from Sebawang High School, Class of 1936. She was secretary of the 1936 Class Reunion Committee, and was a longtime dependable supporter of class events and reunions.

On Dec. 21, 1948, she was married to C.J. Johnson. He preceded her in death Nov. 11, 1980.

Mrs. Johnson had a 33-year career with Michigan Bell Telephone in Detroit before retirement. She was known for her devotion to friends and relatives, to whom she ministered with visits, letters and phone calls.

Surviving are a sister, Minerva Kausch of Madison Heights, and many nieces, nephews and friends.

The funeral service was conducted in Truth Lutheran Church, Detroit, at noon Wednesday, May 31, with interment in Glen Eden Cemetery. Rev. Luther Wright officiated.
