This Non-Language Specific six (6) credit hour, Instructor led course, will outline and familiarize the attendee with professional Interpreter protocol used in conjunction with court testimony and investigations specific to **Domestic Violence** and its associated courtroom proceedings. Attendees can expect to gain a broad understanding of terminology related to a variety of criminal Investigations, forensic evidence collection, investigation specific terminology, and the type of crimes within domestic violence that demand specialized Investigators and associated professionals. In addition to general course information, the Instructor will outline and give an overview of prior investigated domestic violence and sexual assault cases, their outcomes and his experience dealing with language barriers, varied cultural norms, Interpreter ethics issues and confidentiality laws involving these type crimes. This course will feature an overview of domestic violence investigations which includes various "domestic violence" related crimes and the social impact inflicted upon victims and families. Other topics to be covered include, interpreter assisted interviews, sex related crimes and medical examination protocol to name a few.
