NOTICE CITY OF GARNETT BRUSH and FALL CLEAN-UP

The Garnett City Commission has designated the following dates
October 24th through October 28th ONLY for Brush Pick-up for residential areas.
October 31st through November 4th ONLY for Fall Clean-up for residential areas.

Please keep fall clean-up materials separate from weekly solid waste trash that is taken by the refuse department. **Brush and Fall clean-up materials WILL NOT** be picked up by the Refuse Department.

The following guidelines will be followed:

OPEN BURNING

Residents must notify the Anderson Co. Dispatch Center by calling 448-6823 before you start burning.

BRUSH PICK-UP October 24th --- October 28th ONLY free of charge Brush to be accepted includes tree limbs, yard and garden debris only.

Brush is to be piled near the alley or curbside near where weekly trash is picked up. City crews will begin on the north side of the city, working their way south until the entire town has been covered. They will not return to an area once they have been by, so please have all brush to the alley or curbside by 6:00 a.m. on October 24th.

No refuse, trash, or household items will be allowed to be mixed in with brush. If such items are bagged or piled together with brush, then all contents provided for pick-up will not be removed.

RESIDENTIAL FALL CLEAN-UP Oct 31st - Nev 4th ONLY free of charge Crews will start at the north end of town and proceed south until the entire town is covered.

CITY CREWS WILL NOT GO BACK IF THEY HAVE ALREADY BEEN THROUGH THAT PARTICULAR AREA.

Items must be placed in separate piles:

Metal (No Car or Vehicle Parts) Sheet Rock Paper Appliances Shingles Lumber

Furniture Rock/Concrete

NOTE: IF ITEMS ARE NOT PLACED IN SEPARATE PILES, THEY WILL NOT BE PICKED UP

NOTE: ANY APPLIANCES, SUCH AS, REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS, ETC., WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF THEY CONTAIN FREON.

DILAPIDATED BUILDINGS THAT HAVE BEEN DEMOLISHED WILL NOT BE TAKEN. BATTERIES, ELECTRONICS, COMPUTERS, PAINT, OR ANY OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE ITEMS WILL NOT BE TAKEN.
