

June 4, 2024 Meeting with FCP Tribal Council

Call to order 1:16 PM

Attendance: Jason Headson, Lynne Black, Ryan Wilson, Tressa Votis, James Crawford, Todd Mulvey, Heather VanZile, Aaron Loomis, Aiyana VanZile, Brooks Boyd, Destinee Alloway and Nathan Gildan.

A brief discussion took place regarding the contract that was presented to the Town for the signs and striping project. Attorney Loomis was able to clarify an area of concern on the contract. He will be updating the contract and getting it back to the Board for possible approval on June 10, 2024.

Todd Mulvey summarized the sign and stripe project and how it will help with the 2025 construction project that is scheduled on Highway 8. A speed limit discussion took place and Jason stated the Town will be pursuing an ordinance to make 45 MPH on some town roads enforceable. Todd also suggested that shouldering be completed before next summer. The closure is estimated to last at least 5 months.

Tressa brought up the November election and will work with the communications department about voting.
