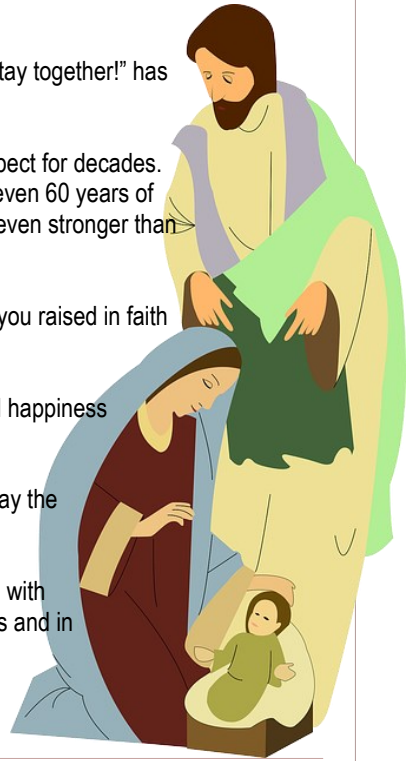
Thank you for enriching our lives with your love and your children, whom you raised in faith and love for God and in respect for others.
