Boulder Ridge Day Camp 2020 Pick-Up and Drop-Off Procedures

Screening Procedures

Every camper will be required to undergo screening procedures upon arrival at camp. Parents will only be allowed to exit their vehicle at drop off/pick up if they need to do so in order to release/fasten the buckles on a young child's safety seat. A special area for unbuckling will be marked. The parent will be required to take each camper's temperature inside the vehicle before the camper gets out. In order to speed the process of drop off we ask that parents bring their own quick read digital or forehead thermometer. We will have extra on hand at camp if needed. The parent will then tell the temperature to the staff member at drop off.

In addition, the following questions will be asked of each camper before they are allowed to exit the vehicle:

- 1. In the last 10 days have you been diagnosed with a confirmed or probable case of Covid 19?
- 2. In the last 14 days have you been in contact with anyone with a confirmed or highly probable case of Covid-19?
- 3. Have you experiences any of these symptoms in the last 24 hours?
 - Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing
 - Cough or respiratory distress
 - Diarrhea or vomiting
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Unexplained muscle or body aches
 - Fatigue
 - Persistent Headache

If your camper is riding with another adult please be sure that the adult conducting drop off knows the answers to these questions for your camper and is comfortable taking your child's temperature. We HIGHLY recommend that you also take your camper's temperature at home each morning before departing to avoid any surprises upon arrival. We will also conduct random temperature checks on campers and staff throughout the camp day. See Sick Policy on page 7 of the Parent Handbook for more info on what to do if your camper is sick or registers a fever.

Drop Off & Pick Up at Camp:

Drop Off: 8:15 – 8:30, 8:30 – 8:45 or 8:45 - 9:00 am Pick Up: 4:00 – 4:15, 4:15 – 4:30, 4:30 - 4:45 pm

You will be assigned a 15 minute time slot for pick up and drop off. A survey will be sent you in advance asking if you need a specific time for a work schedule. If you are sharing driving responsibilities with another family you can use either families scheduled time.

There will be 2 entrances open for drop off which will be clearly labeled. Anyone who must exit their vehicle to unbuckle a camper must use the "Assisted Drop-Off" entrance and pull over in the unbuckling area to get out and unbuckle the camper. You will then return to your vehicle and drive forward to drop off. If you have the earliest time slot (8:15 – 8:30) you may enter our parking lot and get into line as early as 8:05. Please do not arrive before 8:05 as the gate will be closed. We will begin check-in no later than 8:15.

For pickup in the afternoon, enter the gate labeled pick up. A staff member will take your name once you are in line and have your campers ready to enter your vehicle by the time you reach the loading are. Please be prepared with the names of all campers you are picking up and their group numbers. Once you are in line please do not leave your vehicle or pass any other vehicles. If you need to buckle a camper you will be directed to a spot to pullover once the campers are loaded.

We will be checking the ID of any person picking up. Please be sure to bring photo ID daily. If anyone other than the parents/guardians will be picking up your camper, please be sure to list them as authorized adults.
