

TZEDAQAH, Righteous and Innocent

The three Hebrew words below are among the most important words in the Jewish Scriptures -- *and understanding them is essential to understanding the words of Yeshua*. English translators translated them in different ways and that makes it very difficult for readers of English translations to be aware of the Hebrew words behind those translations. I am not going to add any other information about them at this time, except this:

*Acts of **TZEDAQAH** measure **TOV**, create or restore **SHALOM**, and the person doing them is viewed as being **innocent** in the eyes of God.*
