Ordinance Number 726,

An ordinance appropriating certain money's.

Be it ordained by the mayor and commissioners of the city of Garnett, Kansas,

Section One: - that the sum of One Hundred and Seventy Eight and 86/100 Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Special Paving Fund in the hands of the City Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed against said Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 24th day of December 1917. Which bills are for interest due January 1- 1918.from said at fund on the Bonds issued for paving west Seventh Avenue. Alist of said Bills may be found on page of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Two: - that the sum of Seventy Three & 17/100 Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Intersectional Paving Fund in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the Interest due January Ist 1918. a list of which may be found on page of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date. which interest is the amount due from said Fund.

Section Three :- that the Mayor and city clerk be and are hereby authorized and instructed to draw warrants on the city Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed in the foregoing Sections of this Ordinance.

Section Four: - that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force fromand after its passage by the Board of commissioners and its approval by the Mayor.
