National Prayer Event

DOBBS VS. JACKSON WOMEN'S HEALTH (MISSISSIPPI ABORTION CASE) *Did* you know that the United States is only one of four countries, including China and North Korea, that allows the abortion of a child any time during a woman's pregnancy? Mississippi enacted a law in 2018 that limited abortions after 15 weeks. Jackson Women's Health, the only abortion clinic in Mississippi, challenged the law and the Supreme Court will start hearing arguments in this case on Dec 1, 2021.

The Supreme Court will consider the correctness of its previous rulings in Roe v. Wade and Planned Parenthood v. Casey, which severely limits the ability of states to protect their interests in unborn life and maternal health.
