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Description: The existing two three-span interstate bridges were 57 years old and considered structurally deficient due to the poor conditions of the deck, fair conditions of the superstructure and substructure, and intolerable horizontal clearances. The project is located on I-84 at milepost 63.5, approximately 10 miles east of Boise, Idaho. Designed by H.W. Lochner (Lochner), the I-84, Blacks Creek Road Interchange project was Idaho Transportation Department's (ITD) first use of Slide-in Bridge Construction (SIBC) technology on the interstate system, and the second project using a lateral slide of permanent structures in Idaho.

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
