

WESLEY C. TRUEMNER

1903-1994

Wesley C. Truemner, 90, longtime Sebawaing resident and more recently of Caro, died early Friday morning, June 3, in Tuscola County Medical Care Facility, Caro, following a brief illness.

He was born near Kilmanagh on Nov. 8, 1903, the son of John and Katie (Rothliss) Truemner. His father died when he was a teenager, so he and his mother farmed for several years. He worked in a hardware and tin shop in Frankenmuth, coming back to Sebawaing in 1927 to work in the John C. Liken Company store as hardware clerk. In 1933 he started a 40-year career with Sebawaing Gas and Oil Company, then managed by the late Otto Eisengruiser.

In Sebawaing he was an active member with Trinity United Methodist Church, holding various church offices, including 20 years with the cemetery board. He was also active with the Trinity Sunday School and was one of the organizers of Alpha Delta Class.

Mr. Truemner served on the Sebawaing Public School Board from 1943-47.
