Dear Parents/Guardians,

Today, progress reports for grades 4-8 are available for you to view online. Please go to Edge2day.com, click on Reports, then My Child's Progress Report. This year we have enabled the electronic certification option for viewing students' progress reports. Please click on the red *Certify* button at the bottom of your child's progress report so that teachers know that you have viewed it. If you have forgotten how to log on to Edge, please email Ms. DiCola at gdicola@allsaintswebster.org and she will send you the log in information.

For the month of October we will be making a change with the After School Program at the middle school campus. Beginning Monday, all students in ASP at the MS campus will need to take the bus to the Elementary campus to attend ASP there. This arrangement is necessary due to the cost of running the program at two campuses. When basketball season begins in November, we anticipate many more middle school students needing the ASP at the middle school for its proximity to the gym. For that reason, we will go back to hosting ASP at both campuses then. I apologize in advance for any inconvenience and thank you for your cooperation in making this transition a smooth one.
