

## TOWN OF SEDALIA DEVELOPMENT CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE

A Development Clearance Certificate is needed for all development that requires a permit. This includes commercial and residential building permits, grading permits, event permits, sign permits, floodplain development permits, and any other permit required under the Sedalia Development Ordinance or applicable building code (exception: trade permits for existing projects do not require clearance certificate). This certificate must be completely filled out, signed by an authorized Town of Sedalia Official, and submitted to Guilford County Planning and Development Department. Any significant changes made to the original plan must be re-reviewed by the Town of Sedalia, and a new certificate issued. Depending on the type of permit, a plot plan, site plan or other supporting documentation may be required.
