## ORDINANCE #7 SERIES 1982

AN ORDINANCE SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR EACH FUND, AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE TOLD OF MARBLE, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1983.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Marble has appointed LoisAnn McCollum, Clerk/Treasurer, to submit a proposed budget to said governing body at the proper time, and;

WHEREAS, Lois Ann McCollum has submitted a proposed budget to this governing body on 14 September 1982 for its consideration, and;

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, a public hearing was held on 12 October 1982, and interested taxpayers were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget, and;

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO:

Section 1. That estimated expenditures for each fund are as follows:
