


#### The Office Phone

We've had some challenges with finding a way to keep the church office phone attended in a manner that best serves the needs of the congregation. Maintaining a line for voice mail with our current service was cost prohibitive, and varying combinations of phones and answering machines proved futile, as something in building's lines blocks those systems. To best serve you, we have chosen when the office is "unmanned" to forward calls directly to Pastor Roser's cell.
