As a reminder to all attendees: If you are shooting Ironman or are unable to fulfill your duties as a target puller it is up to you to furnish a person to complete your duties. It is not the Whittington Center, the FCSA, or the match director's job to find a puller for you. The Whittington Center does have a list of local people that will work as a puller, but they get taken up rather fast. It is best to have this covered before your arrival. U-Z 2 tomatoes ,1 onion and a bag of leaf lettuce per initial
