

## **How to reduce JPEG Files to 1000 pixels on the Longest side**

Mac OS users can change the resolution of image files using the built-in Preview app used to view, convert and edit images and PDF documents. After opening your image in Preview, select the "Tools" menu and choose "Adjust Size" to see the image's current size and resolution. Change the width to pixels and then change the longest side to 1000. The resolution should be 72.

To resize an image on Windows, you can use the built-in Photos app or Microsoft Paint. In the Photos app, there's a "Resize" option hidden in the side menu, which you can use to change the size and quality of an image.

In Microsoft Paint, you can click "Resize" and then enter the pixel size you want.

You'll get the best results by scaling an image down. If you enlarge your pixels you will get a fuzzy pixelated image
