## *General Information & Treasurer's Report*

Last year our project was South Asia Missions. Our final total for that project was \$13,364. Of that amount I sent \$12,027 to the BMAA Missions office for our missionary and put \$668 in our General Fund and \$668 in our youth fund.

Now let's get busy on our new Project of supporting Texas Missions to provide study Bibles and other study materials for our Texas Missionaries. Our Texas Missionaries are ministering to different people groups in Texas with different languages other than English. They need Bibles and study materials in their languages. We want to provide quality translations and study materials for them.

Our new theme for next year will be "Taste and See" taken from Psalm 34:8. Dianna introduced this theme at the meeting and I am sure we will be hearing more from her about that.

In July at their houseparty, the Sunbeams elected a new project, Larry and Tammy Wood serving in the Czech Republic helping the Ukrainian Refugees. I have included a flyer about that project and if you would like to help them Support these missionaries, you can send your money to me, and mark it "Sunbeam Project". Many of us know Larry and Tammy and might like to help with this.

Our current General Fund balance is \$1052 so don't forget to support the general fund when you send in your reports. As usual I have included report forms for you to use when you send in either Project or General Fund Money. Please report to me at least once a year and every quarter you have money to send so that we can keep a current list of our active Women's Ministries. At our state meeting last year, we adopted a new Manual and Guidebook, so that we can keep our state work in line with our national work. This year we added some changes to it. That handbook can be found on our TX WMA website, [www.texaswma.com](http://www.texaswma.com). One of the changes from the past is that you don't have to be called WMA to be a part of our Texas WMA or our National WMA. Any local women's ministry can be part of our work and are entitled to send messengers to our state and national meetings. I look forward to hearing from new churches because of this change. If you know of a church that is not receiving this newsletter, please send me their information so I can add them to our e-mail and mailing list.

Texas WMA met November 8, 2022 at Livingston Baptist Church. President Kristi Key presided over the business portion of the meeting and gave a warm welcome to everyone. Jackie Ricks led the opening prayer. Ms. Key then read Matthew 5:14 and a special poem written by Claudie Thompson, in tribute to Ann Pugh, who recently passed away. Betty Blakley welcomed everyone to Livingston BC.

Visitors, missionaries, church planters, National WMA officers, former state WMA presidents, pastor's wives and pastors were recognized.

National WMA president Charlotte Johnson encouraged the ladies to attend the national meeting next year in Conway, Arkansas. She then led the WMA motto. Song leader Cindy Allen, accompanied on the piano by Vera Koonce, led the WMA song, "Called".

GMA promoter Hayley Rasco introduced her younger sister, Aileena Maynard, who is representing the state as Texas Junior Miss GMA. Ms. Maynard read from Matthew 6:23. We had the opportunity to view a video by Texas (and National) Miss GMA, Audrey Johnson. She spoke on Isaiah 60:22 and Romans 8:28.

Cindy Allen and Glenda Chamberlain awarded door prizes. President Key called the business meeting to order with the seating of the messengers. Sunbeam Promoter Vera Koonce spoke of the fun Houseparty held during the summer at Jacksonville College, and encouraged all churches who have children to make plans to come to the 2023 Houseparty. Theme for next year will be "Tis So Sweet"

Hayley Rasco gave a report on the GMA Houseparty held at First, Jacksonville last spring. She mentioned the next houseparty will be at Daniel Springs March 10-11, 2023. Theme will be "Spread the Word."

Project promoter Jeannie Walker gave a brief report of our project, JW of Southeast Asia. Ms. Walker presented certificates to the churches with the top donations. Year-to-date donations total \$13,192.77. All monies received through the end of November will be applied to the current project.

President Key announced the following committees: Registration – Alicia Johnson, Cathie Ross, and Melissa Halley; Petitionary letters – Sandy Jones, Berenda Mewborn, and Joan Decker; Finance – Jo Strong, Charlotte Johnson, and Johnnie Ross; Resolutions – Ann Bergman, Sandra Kizer, and Bettye Wilson.

Kerri Heuermann of the project selection committee presented the two choices for projects for the coming year. Johnnie Ross spoke about the need to provide Bibles for our Texas mission locations. Then a video was shown about the Jeevan Prakash School in India. After a vote, the Texas mission project was selected and made unanimous after a motion and second.

The slate of new officer nominations was accepted as a whole. Texas WMA 2<sup>nd</sup> vice president Diana Morris presented each officer with a delightful bag of holiday stovetop simmer. The simmer represented her theme for the coming year "Taste and See" from Psalm 34:8. Kristi thanked Elizabeth Midkiff for her many years of work as a recording secretary.

After nominations were open for the new position on the nominating committee, Elizabeth Midkiff was elected. Also elected from the floor were the new advisory council: Bro. Jed Whitaker, Bro. Leon Ross, and Bro. Adam Key.

The registration committee gave their report of 54 messengers and 19 visitors for a total of 73 present from 45 churches, 1 state and 1 foreign country.

Cindy Allen led the group in singing "I Love to Tell the Story." Then we were blessed by Lindsie Burchett singing "I the Lord of Sea and Sky." Diana Morris introduced the guest speaker, Cheryl Hughes.

Ms. Hughes spoke of how we could all help carry out the great commission of Matthew 28:19-20. She told of her many BMMI trips to various countries. She encouraged us to consider going on a mission trip by saying "You are never too old and it's not too late."

Diana Morris and Jason Prewitt did a skit to highlight the national project of Daniel Springs Encampment. Following that, Bro. Jason blessed the delicious BBQ lunch which Livingston BC provided.

Following lunch, Kristi reminded everyone about the upcoming 2023 retreats: spring retreat at LakeRidge, Lubbock and fall retreat at Cornerstone, Jacksonville.

Diana Morris introduced the afternoon speaker, Rose Ng. Rose spoke of her journey to salvation and education for her mission work. She shared her ten-year plan for beginning a school in Cambodia to help the children of the boat people.

Kristi Key led in the final prayer before dismissing the WMA meeting.


