
P.J. Adeji-Paul #24


Brian Alderman #63


Logan Allison #87


Garrett Bennett #76


Kody Chappell #57


Ty Cobb #72


Eric Davis #29

After missing most of his junior year with a hand injury, Eric has battled back stronger and faster than ever. His height and hands will enable him to make a great impact for the Trojan offense this season.




Timmy Dial #12


Jamie Edwards #60


Shane Farrier #78


Luke Hill #37


Mitch Hill #33


Keith (Stumpy) McIntyre #62


Keith Mefford #23


Evan Nichols #17


Devin Reed #35


Brad Regal #81


Chance Robbins #40


Chris Sawyer #30


Tanner Shuck #7


Paul Taylor #38


Mitch Thomas #71
