



Sino US Performing Arts Organization (SINOUS) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization specialized in Chinese art and culture. It has served a diverse audience and bridged intercultural understanding through art education, performances and cultural events, in partnership with academic, cultural and community organizations. Its signature programs include C Dream Program, Sino Cultural Day and SINOUSARTS@COMMUNITY.

SINOUS provides high quality Chinese cultural events and community programs on a low cost basis, and customizes them per venue and theme needs, as stand-alone or add-on programs.

Partnership Event

A typical partnership event is comprised of performance(s) and/or demonstration(s), supplemented by cultural activities to enrich visitor experience. Performance and demonstration can take the form of Chinese music, dance, opera, face-changing or martial arts. Alternatively, a workshop of selected form can be arranged to engage the audience in a more active way.

Event partner covers its partnership share of the program costs, and provides venue, equipment and/or device(s) and related technical, staffing and marketing supports. SINOUS provides and manages the performances and activities it brings to the event, provides funding to close the budget gap, and publicizes the event through its channels.
